

## **Commercial Rate Clarification Request**

By resolution **RES 2014-0077** the City of Spokane established an administrative policy and procedure regarding the clarification of its Commercial Utility Rate (Incentive) deeming that buildings located in a Commercial, Center and Corridor, or Downtown Zone may be billed for utilities at a commercial utility rate should the building have been previously billed at commercial rates and converts to housing or a mixed use building.

Administrative Policy 5200-14-04 requires that the Customer/Applicant(s) needs to take action for the incentive be applied and staff needs to confirm that qualifying requirements have been met.
