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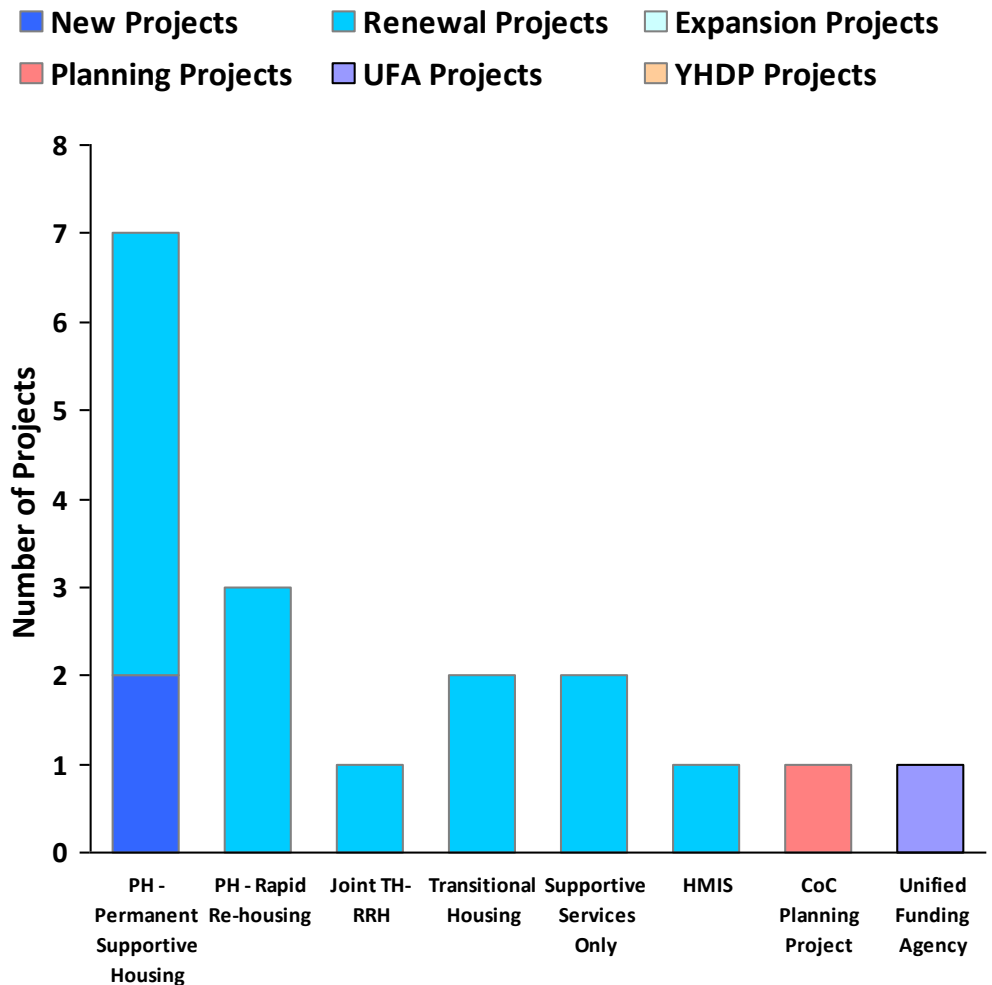
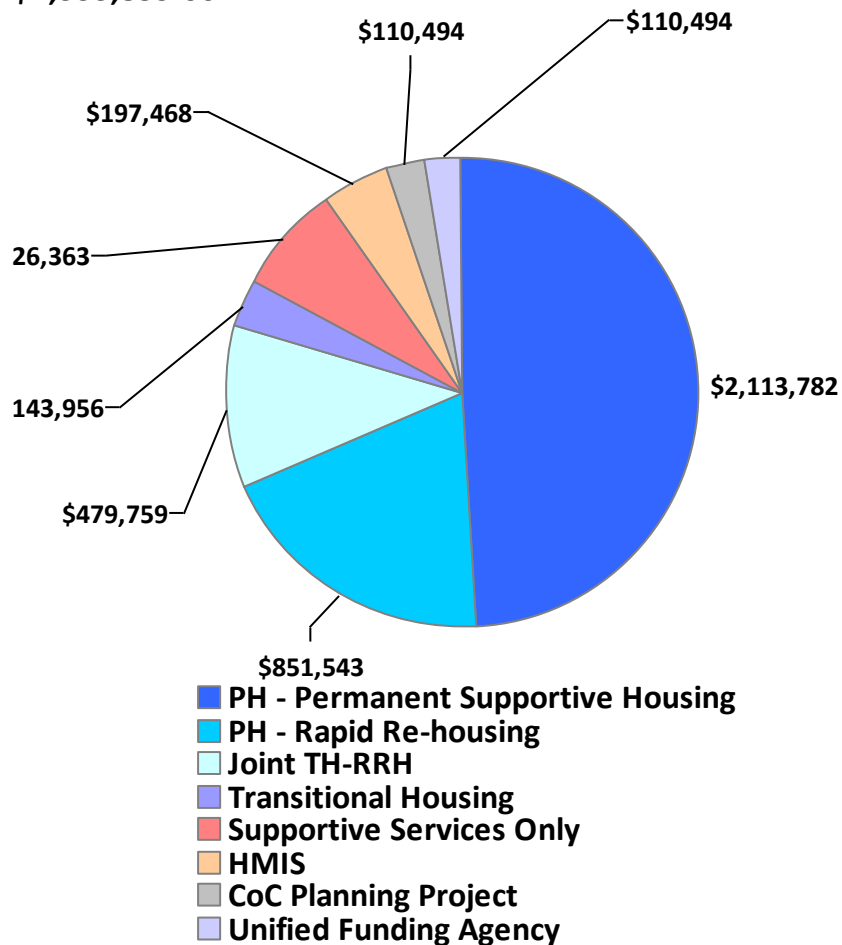

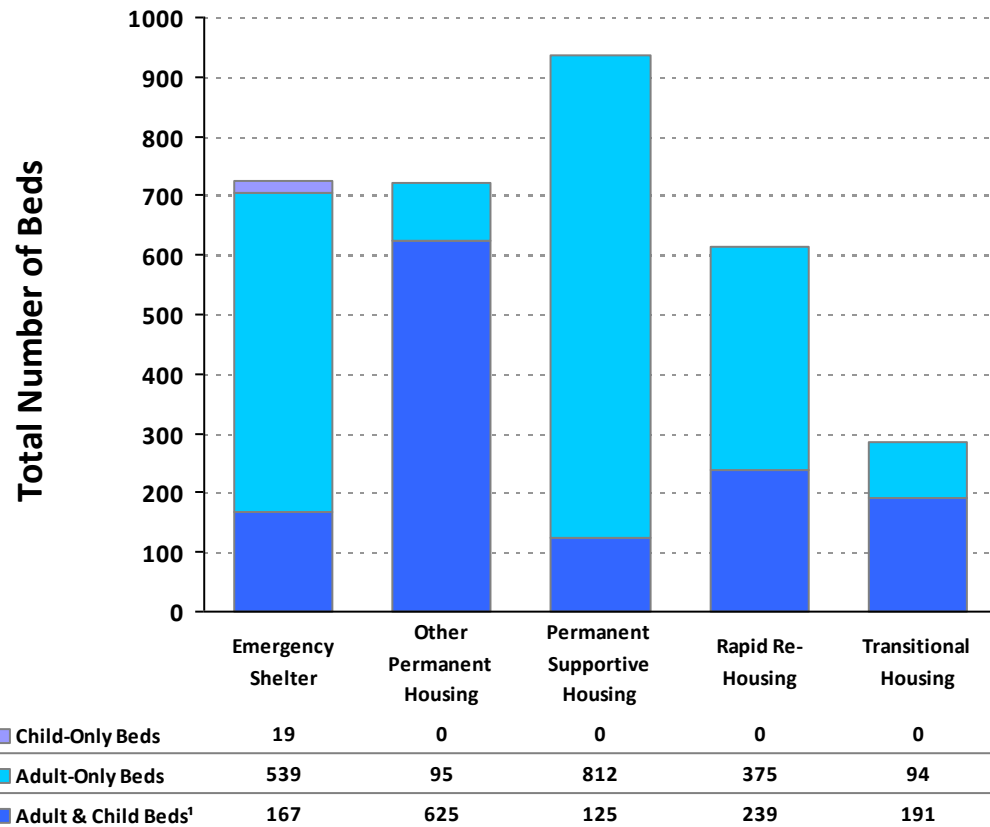
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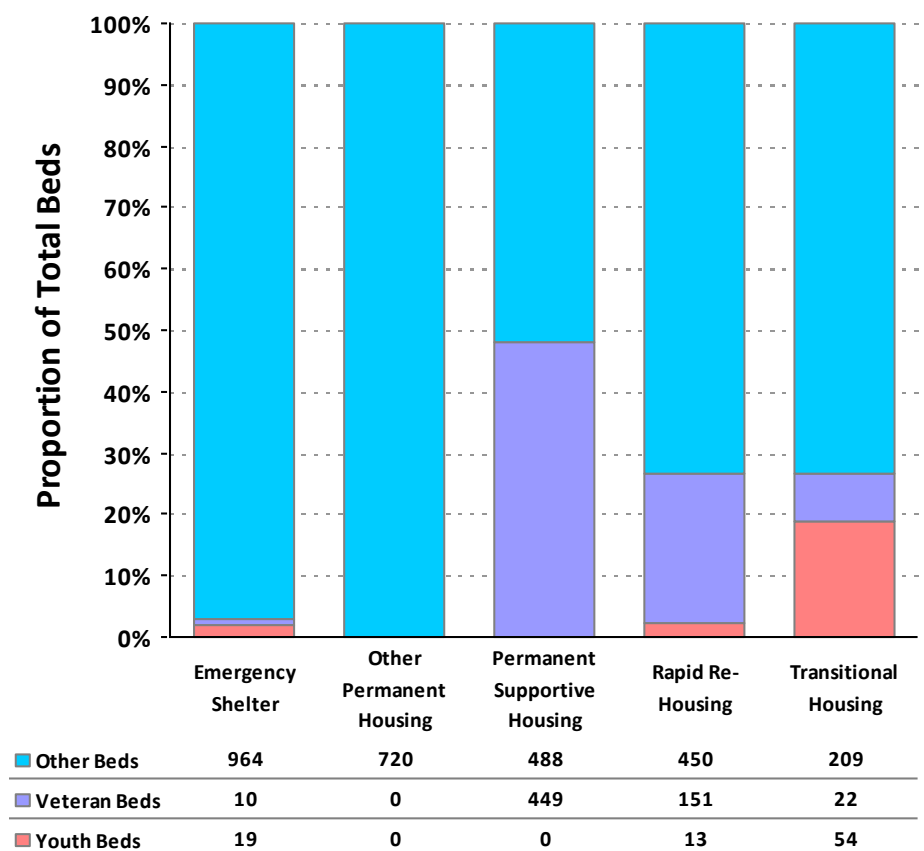

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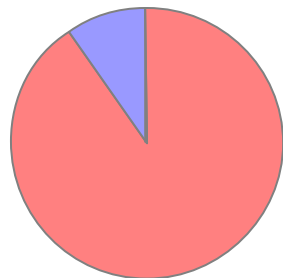

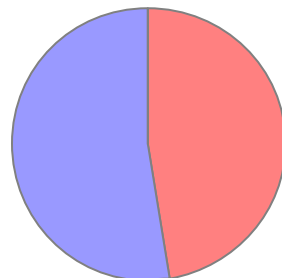

### Proportion of Households Served by Program Type

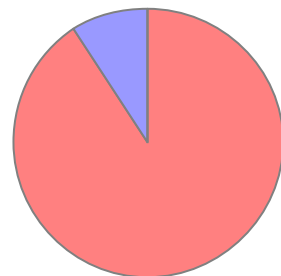
Emergency Transitional Unsheltered\*\*



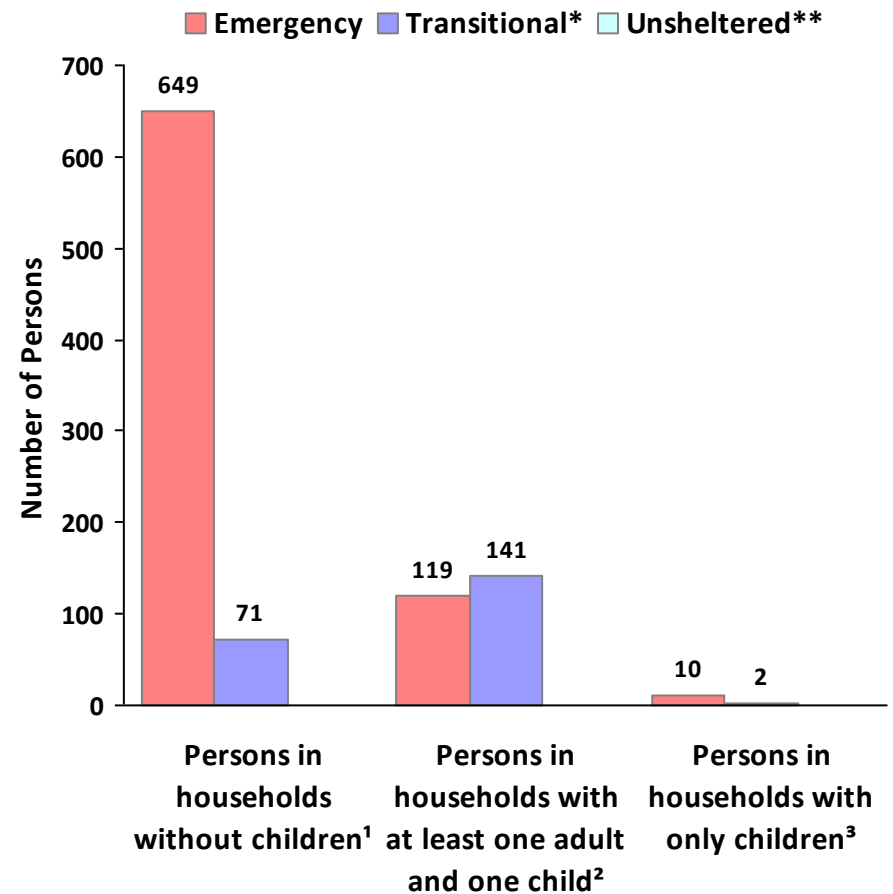
Households without children<sup>1</sup>

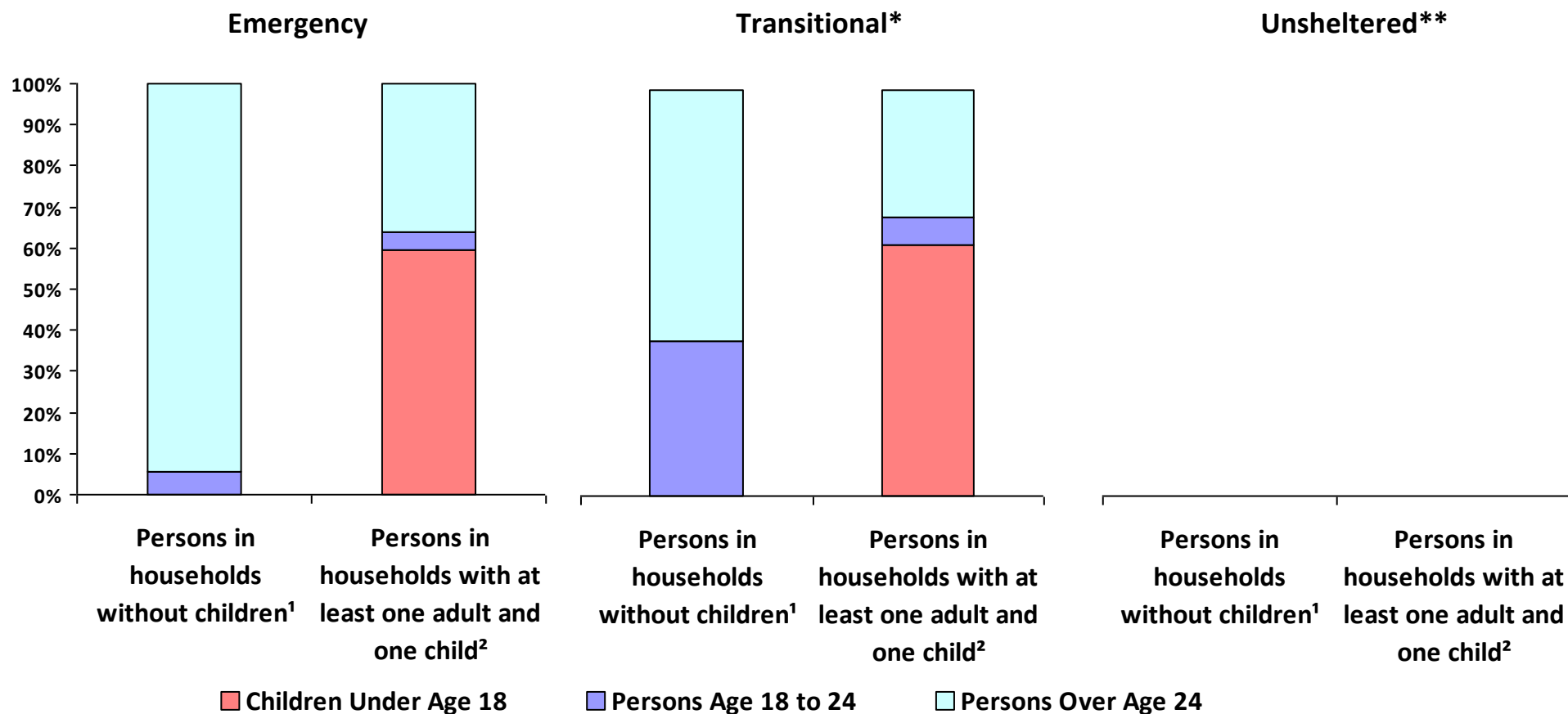

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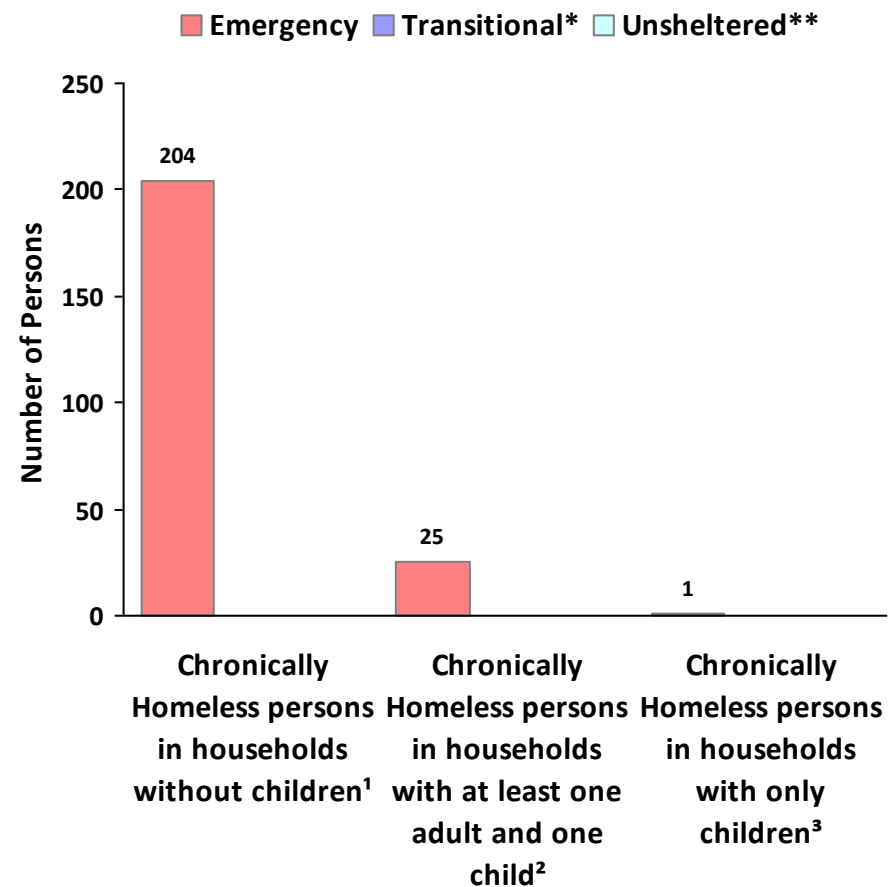
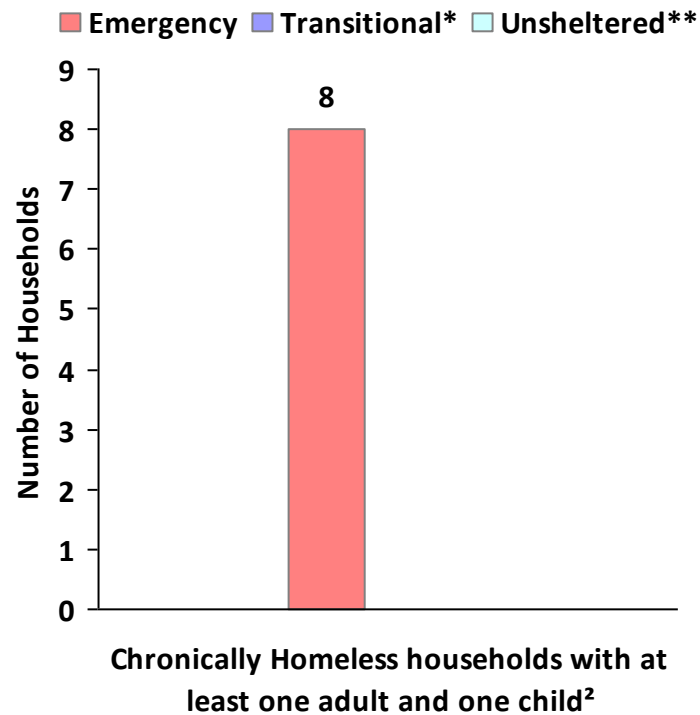

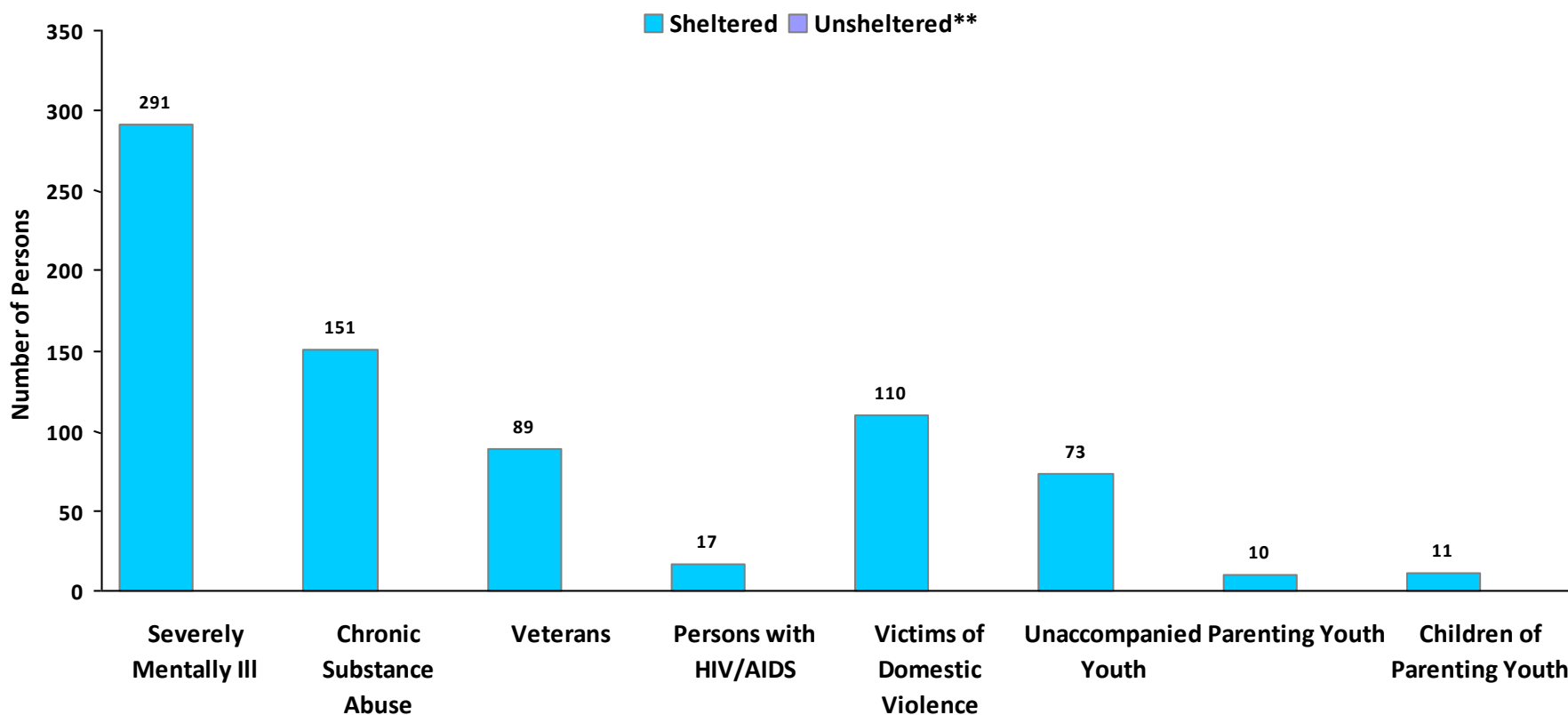
