The Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine is the only COVID-19 vaccine that has received authorization for use in individuals age 12 and older. The Johnson & Johnson and Moderna vaccines are authorized for use in those 18 and older. So, keep this in mind or ask a teenage family member to keep this in mind, when scheduling.
