

Be Fire Smart



Recreational Fires



Use clean, dry firewood or manufactured logs



Burn 25 feet away



Have extinguisher or hose nearby



Stay near the fire



Keep it small



Put it out completely (no smoke)



Never Burn garbage, yard waste, or construction materials

Don't use burn barrels, or annoy neighbors



Levels of Burning in Spokane

Open Burning – Follow normal fire safety rules.

- Can cook food
- Can use fire pits and portable devices



Burn Restriction – Limits on types of fires.

- Can cook food (only on gas or BBQ grills)
- Due to hot and dry weather, sparks are the biggest risk.
- Need chimney and spark arrestor/screen
