

Dear Guests, Friends, and Loyal Customers,

We hope you had a wonderful golf season this year. Weather was ideal for the majority of the season despite a few smokey days in the midsummer, and we couldn't have hoped for better fall weather while getting in those last few rounds. 2021 was a strong year for the City of Spokane Golf with over 165,000 rounds played across all four courses. Thank you!

As we wrap up 2021, we'd like to ensure you're aware of some updates.

Facility Improvements & Master Planning

As you may know, in June 2018 we implemented a [Facility Improvement Fee](#) that is built into our golf rates. Those fees are earmarked to help repay our loan from the City of Spokane, which totals \$7.5M. Facility Improvement Fees will remain the same in 2022.

To date, Facility Improvements have included:

- Irrigation replacement at Indian Canyon, and a rebuild of greens at 5, 8, 9, 12 & 17
- Irrigation replacement at Esmeralda
- Irrigation replacement at Downriver, which began just after Labor Day this year, and is scheduled to last through late spring/early summer of 2022.

Irrigation improvements at Creek at Qualchan are expected in the future.

The rate changes for 2022 primarily come down to truing-up operational deficiencies caused by rising costs for labor, chemicals, materials, and equipment. They also aim to simplify the rate structure.

Rates for all City courses are now the same across the board, with a modest fee increase going towards operating budget increases mentioned above, and capital outlay.

This modest increase allows us to continue offering the same elevated level of service and turf quality while investing more money in capital improvements both on and off course. Capital improvements may include, but are not limited to: clubhouse renovations, HVAC upgrades, bunker sand, tee leveling, parking lots, and turf equipment purchases, to name a few.
