ALL IN-PERSON PUBLIC HEARINGS
BEFORE THE HEARING EXAMINER

Due to the public health emergency created by the COVID-19 outbreak, it is hereby ORDERED that all in-person public hearings before the Hearing Examiner are suspended until such time as the proceedings can be conducted in a manner that is consistent with the policies and guidance of state and local government officials and otherwise does not pose a significant risk to public health and safety. The Hearing Examiner intends to schedule in-person public hearings to take place within thirty (30) days after emergency conditions are no longer present and any material restrictions on the conduct of in-person public hearings have been lifted.

Consistent with the Governor's Proclamations 20-05 and 20-28, until normal operations are resumed, the Hearing Examiner may conduct public hearings by telephone, video, or other means that do not require in-person attendance, in appropriate cases. For such matters, the Hearing Examiner will issue a prehearing order setting forth, among other things, the pre-hearing notice requirements, the general rules and procedures for remote attendance or participation, and an agenda for the hearing.
