



Requesting an Accommodation for a Civil Service Exam

If you need reasonable accommodation for your Civil Service exam, please read the following information:

Depending on an individual's needs, reasonable accommodation will be provided.

- After you have submitted your online application and have been invited to test, you will need to submit your request for accommodation to the Civil Service department.
- Please notify us as soon as you are invited to test so we have enough time to coordinate. If we are not given advanced notice we may not be able to provide the accommodation that you require.
- You must specify what the functional limitation is so we are able to accommodate appropriately. Documentation of the disability is required and must be issued from a licensed medical professional, a licensed vocational rehabilitation specialist, or any agency that issues or provides disability benefits. We have the utmost regard for privacy regarding this information, and only use it for the required purpose.
