JOB DESCRIPTION

Our Flag Football referees enforce the rules of the Spokane Parks and Recreation Flag Football league Fridays and Sundays. Our league is the biggest and best in Spokane with 4 divisions of 8 v 8 flag football, as well as a 5 v 5 division. There is also the opportunity to referee our youth NFL Flag Football league for player's ages 5-15 years old. Pay starts at \$15 an hour. The job tasks include:

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Enforcing Flag Football rules as outlined by the Spokane Parks and Recreation Athletics department.
- Mediate possible confrontations.
- Implement program safety policies and procedures.
- Serve as a responsible ambassador for the SPRD athletics department.
- Communicate efficiently and respectfully with players.
- Keep up with the physical demands required of the job.
- Be firm and confident in decision-making.
- Taking control in potentially intense and uncomfortable situations.
- Game management and time management.
- Additional duties as assigned.
- Be responsible in showing up for shifts on time and communicating any scheduling conflicts with management.
