GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Custodial Rover crew members will generally work in teams of two and will be assigned to specific park locations to rove the grounds to pick up lose trash and empty trash cans. In addition park bathroomfacilities will be cleaned using certain cleaning agents and implements. It is expected that minor sink and toilet clogs will be attempted to be fixed with unsuccessful attempts reported to supervisor. Minor graffiti removal and litter pickup will be a regular occurrence. It is expected that all staff are mindful of the general condition of our parks and report all hazards or suspicious activities. Typical shift is 6am-2:30pm and will work weekends and holidays with a maximum total hours worked in a year of 960 hours.

- Manual dexterity to drive a motor vehicle and for basic cleaning tasks
