

FLOW MONITOR INSTALLATION TECH \$15.00/hour (Temporary Position not to exceed six months)

NATURE OF WORK:

- Skilled work that is medium to heavy in nature. The majority of the work requires entry into active sewer lines and is often in traffic. Primarily works as a team of two, however some work is done independently.
- Use of computers for data logger programming and data collection.
- Use of hand and power tools.

EXAMPLES OF WORK:

- Assist in the installation and maintenance of open-channel flow monitoring equipment which involves:
 - Confined space entry into active sewer and storm lines
 - Performing confined space attendant duties
 - Troubleshooting electronic flow monitoring and cellular modem equipment
 - Using power tools such as Roto-hammers, sawzalls, impact wrenches, laser levels, etc.
 - Using hands tools such as screwdrivers, wrenches, tape measures, and shovels
 - Programming electronic flow monitors and cellular modems
 - Working in traffic
- Assist with installation and maintenance of electronic rain gauge equipment and Hydrogen Sulfide data-loggers:
 - Working at heights up to 70 feet
 - Climbing ladders and operating bucket trucks
 - Programming and troubleshooting electronic data loggers and modems
 - Working in traffic

REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be dependable
- Must be detail oriented
- Must have enough physical mobility to climb up and down stationary ladders in narrow (24") manholes
- Must have enough physical mobility to crawl on hands and knees up active sewer lines
- Must be proficient with a computer and able to learn and utilize specialized software packages
- Able to read and comprehend technical information
- Must have a valid Washington State driver's license and dependable transportation
- Must be able to work in all weather conditions
- Must pass a physical exam (with drug test and demonstration of proper lifting up to 50 pounds)
- Must provide your own hard soled over-ankle work boots (steel toes not required, but recommended)
- Coveralls and personal protective equipment (PPE) will be provided

PERSONNEL REQUIREMENTS:

- Must have approved form of picture ID
- Must have dependable transportation
