NATURE OF WORK:

- Assist permanent employees
- Performs semi-skilled work in the Solid Waste Management/Landfill Transfer Station Department. Regular contact with the public is required directing the unloading of yard waste, recyclable materials and garbage. Duties are routine requiring some independent judgement in making minor decisions in operating procedures. Requires no previous experience or manipulative skills. Works under limited supervision. Work is medium in nature, performed under a number of disagreeable conditions including: inclement weather, dust, odors and exposure to household hazardous materials. Work hours are variable, may work any day of the week (7 days a week operation).

EXAMPLES OF WORK:

- Explains HazMat recycling and composting to citizens and distributes printed information.
- Directs dumping operations at Waste to Energy tipping floor.
- Inspects, distinguishes and preliminarily sorts acceptable and non-acceptable wastes/recyclable materials into distinct categories. Directs the disposal of these materials accordingly.
- Polices, clears, cleans and maintains in and around building and grounds.
- Cleans tools and equipment at worksite.

REQUIREMENTS OF WORK:

- Able to work around heavy equipment for extended periods, often under unfavorable conditions
- Good physical condition and health
- Ability to perform semi-skilled tasks without close supervision
- Ability to get along well with citizens.
- Able to read and comprehend technical information as applies to department policy and site operation procedures
- See well enough to read fine print on bottles
- Able to hear and speak well enough to talk over intercom, and on hand-held radios
- Body mobility to walk and stoop and stand for long periods
- Stamina needed for standing on concrete for extended periods
- Must be able to lift and pour (5) gallon bucket of oil
- Tolerance to work under adverse conditions such as odors, dust, inclement weather, wearing personal protective equipment

NO MINIMUM EDUCATION OR EXPERIENCE REQUIRED

DEPARTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be dependable
- Must be able to work well with others
- Must be willing to work weekends
- Must have reliable transportation (reliable public transportation not available to the site)

- Must have a Social Security Card
- Must have approved form of picture ID
