PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Shalom Ministries has served the poor and hungry homeless of Spokane with food and support for 25 years utilizing countless volunteers, donors and supportive churches of many denominations; and

WHEREAS, Spokane, in spite of a robust economy, is challenged to provide dignified support for a sometimes-intractable population of homeless and underserved men, women, and youth; and

WHEREAS, many of our guests suffer from addiction and mental illness, and otherwise lack the tools for seeking help through more traditional channels of treatment.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nadine Woodward, Mayor of the City of Spokane, on behalf of the citizens of Spokane, do hereby proclaim February 29th, 2020 as

SHALOM DAY OF DIGNITY

in Spokane, recognizing Shalom Ministries as an agent of positive response to the pervasive blight of homelessness on our otherwise beautiful city.
