PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Make-A-Wish Alaska and Washington grants the wishes of children with critical illnesses and will celebrate its 35th anniversary in 2021; and

WHEREAS, since its inception in 1986, the local Spokane chapter has granted wishes to more than 7,500 children, and when a wish is granted, a child replaces: fear with confidence, sadness with joy and anxiety with hope; and

WHEREAS, the wishes have proven physical and emotional benefits that can give children with critical illnesses a higher chance of survival and transforms the lives of children, their families, volunteers, supporters, medical professionals and entire communities:
