## PROCLAMATION

**WHEREAS**, Tyler Johnson was born and raised in Spokane, WA, graduated from Central Valley High School, and during his youth, played for the Coeur d'Alene Lakers Youth program; and

**WHEREAS**, Tyler played for the Spokane Chiefs from 2007 - 2011 and was a top player, helping the team win a Western Hockey League Championship, Memorial Cup Championship, and recognition in the Chief's Top 35 in 35 Years list during his four seasons, while also bringing home a gold medal as part of Team USA at the 2010 World Junior Championship; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2011, Tyler signed a contract with the Tampa Bay Lightning, playing in the American Hockey League for two seasons before being called up by the Lightning in 2013 to make his National Hockey League (NHL) debut, and after establishing himself in their top offensive line, was named to the NHL All-Rookie Team; and

**WHEREAS**, Tyler Johnson has established himself as a top NHL player, helping the Tampa Bay Lightning to win back-to-back Stanley Cup Championships, joining only seven other teams in NHL history to accomplish the repeat feat:
