PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, emergencies can occur at any time that require police, fire or emergency medical services, and when an emergency occurs the prompt response of police officers, firefighters and paramedics is critical to the protection of life and preservation of property; and

WHEREAS, the safety of our police officers and firefighters is dependent upon the quality and accuracy of information obtained from citizens who telephone the City of Spokane emergency communications center; and

WHEREAS, Public Safety Telecommunicators are the first and most critical contact our citizens have with emergency services and are the single vital link for our police officers and firefighters by monitoring their activities by radio, providing them information and ensuring their safety, and Public Safety Telecommunicators of the City of Spokane have contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires and treatment of patients:
