WHEREAS, Paul McCartney is one of the most prolific, gifted, and celebrated songwriters in music history, writing and collaborating on songs that span over six decades, including post-Beatles hits such as *Uncle Albert/Admiral Halsey* (1971), *Band on the Run* (1973), *Mull of Kintyre* (1978), *Ebony and Ivory* (1982), *Do They Know It's Christmas* (2004), and *FourFiveSeconds* (2015); and

WHEREAS, Paul McCartney, although most widely known for having sold millions of records, recording dozens of number one hits, and profoundly influencing musicians in every genre, has used his success to help raise billions of dollars for charities through personal donations and performances at historic benefit concerts; and

WHEREAS, Spokane is excited and honored to welcome Paul McCartney, performing his first show ever in our City and marking the debut of the 13-city national tour *Got Back*:
