PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, in 1949 a congressional charter signed by President Truman established the National Trust for Historic Preservation, launching the use of historic preservation as an effective tool for community revitalization, economic development and enhancing livability; and

WHEREAS, the Spokane Historic Preservation Office was created in 1981 and since has received national and statewide recognition for its innovative and productive approach to historic preservation; while also recognizing the contributions that many dedicated individuals have made in preserving Spokane's heritage; and

WHEREAS, in the past five years, seventy-seven historic preservation rehabilitation projects were completed resulting in over \$132 million dollars invested in Spokane's historic properties:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nadine Woodward, Mayor of the City of Spokane, on behalf of the citizens of Spokane, do hereby proclaim May 2022 as

HISTORIC PRESERVATION MONTH

in Spokane and encourage citizens to join the Spokane City-County Historic Preservation Office and the Spokane City-County Historic Landmarks Commission by taking part in celebratory activities, including taking part in free walking tours of downtown Spokane with Historic Preservation staff members.
