**WHEREAS**, September 17, 2023, marks the two hundred thirty-sixth anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America, a document which stands as a testament to the tenacity of Americans through history to maintain their liberties, freedoms, and inalienable rights; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1956, due to the passionate advocacy of the Daughters of the American Revolution, President Eisenhower signed Public Law 915, a joint resolution which guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17 through 23 as Constitution Week; and

**WHEREAS**, it is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this magnificent document and its memorable anniversary and to the patriotic celebrations which will commemorate the occasion:

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Nadine Woodward, Mayor of the City of Spokane, on behalf of the citizens of Spokane, do hereby proclaim September 17-23, 2023, as
