## PROCLAMATION

**WHEREAS**, street music has a rich history of building relationships, promoting cultures, and forwarding the arts through providing a stage for musicians of all ages who might not otherwise have a venue; and

**WHEREAS**, Spokane is a city rich in traditions and generosity, and since 2002, local musicians, dignitaries, philanthropists, raconteurs, and vaudevillians have raised over \$270,000 during Street Music Week for Second Harvest Inland Northwest which provides over a million meals for our neighbors; and

**WHEREAS**, this is the 21<sup>st</sup> annual Spokane Street Music Week all along the downtown corridor and the Garland District during the noon hour – a lively event which adds to the rich culture of the Metropolitan Spokane regional area with songs filling the air and food filling the shelves of our food bank:
