PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the United States observes March 29th every year as National Vietnam War Veterans Day in recognition of March 29, 1973, the day the last U.S. combat troops left Vietnam, and is a day to thank and honor our nation's veterans and recognize the sacrifices that they and their families made during the Vietnam War; and

WHEREAS, in all, approximately 2,700,000 Americans served in the Vietnam War, over 58,000 died in the conflict, and more than 150,000 were wounded, and as of today, more than 1,500 are still listed as missing; and

WHEREAS, Vietnam veterans endured unspeakable hardships and endangered their lives fighting for our American values, and we cannot measure the debt of gratitude we owe these brave men and women who served, were wounded, or died in defense of the values we hold dear:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nadine Woodward, Mayor of the City of Spokane, on behalf of the citizens of Spokane, do hereby proclaim March 29, 2023 as

in Spokane to honor those men and women who served their country faithfully and courageously during the Vietnam conflict.
