WHEREAS, September 17, 2024 marks the two hundred thirty-seventh anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America, a document which stands as a testament to the tenacity of Americans through history to maintain their liberties, freedoms, and inalienable rights; and

WHEREAS, in 1956, due to the passionate advocacy of the Daughters of the American Revolution, President Eisenhower signed Public Law 1915, a joint resolution which guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17 through 23 as Constitution Week; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this magnificent document and its memorable anniversary and to the patriotic celebrations which will commemorate the occasion:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Lisa Brown, Mayor of the City of Spokane, on behalf of the people of Spokane, do hereby proclaim September 17-23, 2024 as
