PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the United States National POW/MIA Recognition Day is observed across the Nation on the third Friday of September each year so that Americans take time to remember those who were prisoners of war (POW) and those who are missing in action (MIA) as well as their families; and

WHEREAS, Ensign John R. Monaghan Post 51 Veterans of Foreign Wars has recognized that 83,000 American Service Personnel are still missing in action. These Service Men and Women are assumed dead but are still unaccounted for, and service of those who were prisoners of war as well as those who are missing in action; and

WHEREAS, Ensign John R. Monaghan Post 51 Veterans of Foreign Wars shall observe the 20th of September 2024 to pause and remember the sacrifices and services of those who were prisoners of war as well as those who are missing in action:
