I understand that such electronic transmission will have the same legal effect as if I had received the document, pleading, and/or correspondence via USPS 1st class mail. I may revoke this authorization at any time by sending written notice to the Court. I understand it is my responsibility to check my email inbox regularly to assure timely receipt of items from the Court. If the Court receives an undeliverable message for the email address provided, they will revert to sending all items related to my cases to the last mailing address on file.
