

What Is An Illegal Dump?



Depositing or disposing of any garbage, litter or discarded items

- in any public place, public park or in the waters within the City limits.
- on private property of another without the property owner's permission.
- into any garbage can, dumpster or other receptacle located on the property of another, except for containers placed in an area and designated for public use.

- Remember: **FORMS MUST BE SIGNED** – anonymous complaints not accepted, non-disclosure option available.

Information Needed For Form

Identification of the persons who left the items is needed for complaints. This includes:

- license plate number,
- a witness who recognized the persons leaving the items,
- something found which identifies the persons such as an old bill or a magazine subscription,
- ID must have a name AND address.

Remember

- You must have identification of the dumper to file a report.
- The City does not go through illegal dumps to find identifying material.
- Any illegal dump without identification becomes the responsibility of the property owner.
- Ultimately, it is the property owner's responsibility to clean-up the debris, but our officers can aid in contacting the violator.

Penalties for Illegally Dumping
