



• Gross Rent in the City of Spokane




• Gross Rent as a Percentage of Income








• Rental Housing Unit Density



 Rental Housing Age of Structure: this data is not based upon original build date but rather based upon the last permit pulled for the structure (additions, remodels, etc). Data for single unit structures only.



• Rental Housing Age of Structure: based upon original build date.



- Rental Housing with Below-Average Conditions:
 - Determining Condition: curb-side exterior physical condition:
 - Very Poor: undesirable, unoccupied
 - Poor: unattractive, excessive turnover
 - Average: still somewhat attractive and desirable
 - Good: quite attractive and desirable
 - Excellent: extremely attractive and highly desirable
