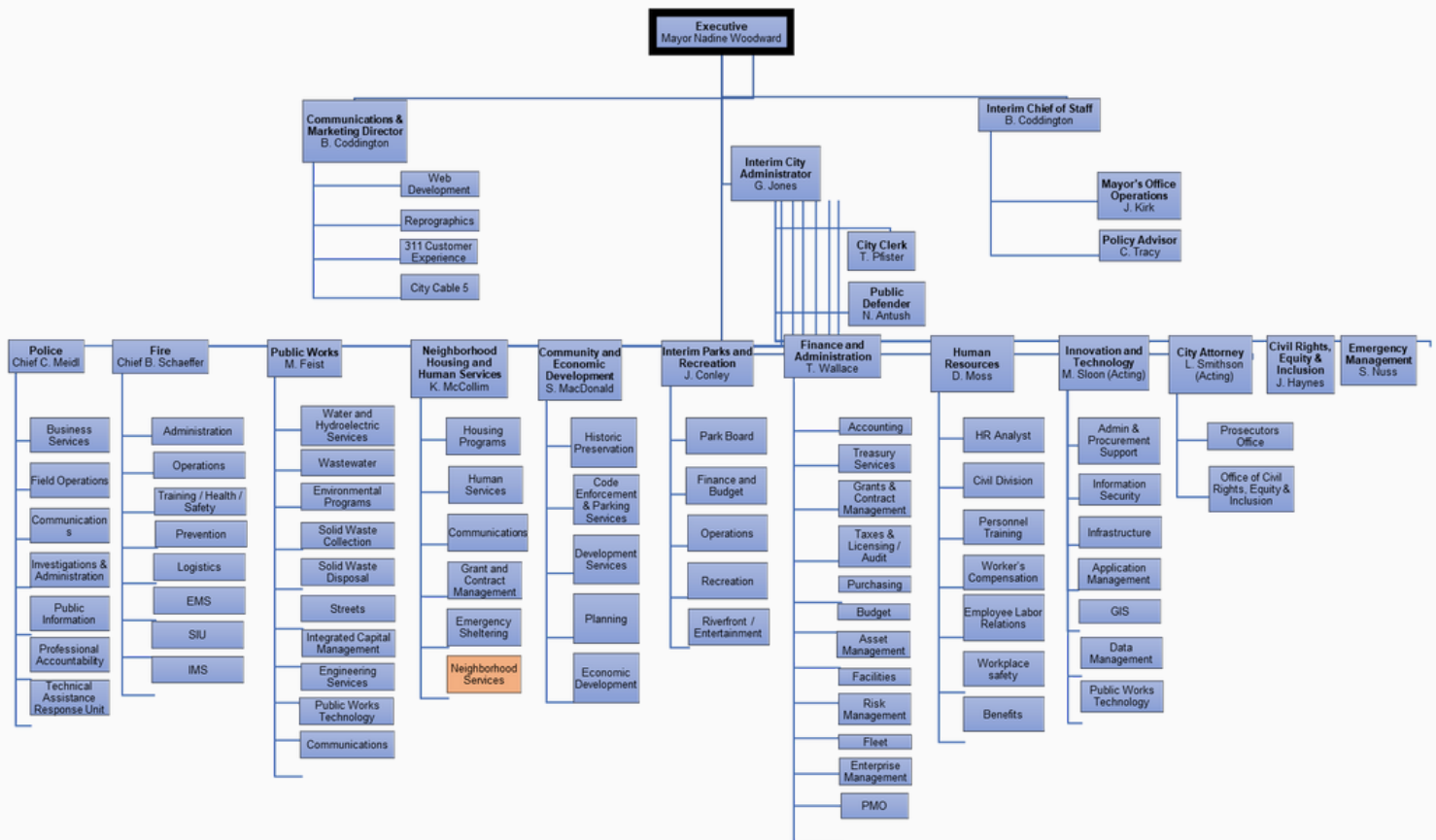
Mayor is Executive authority responsible for operations and implementing policy



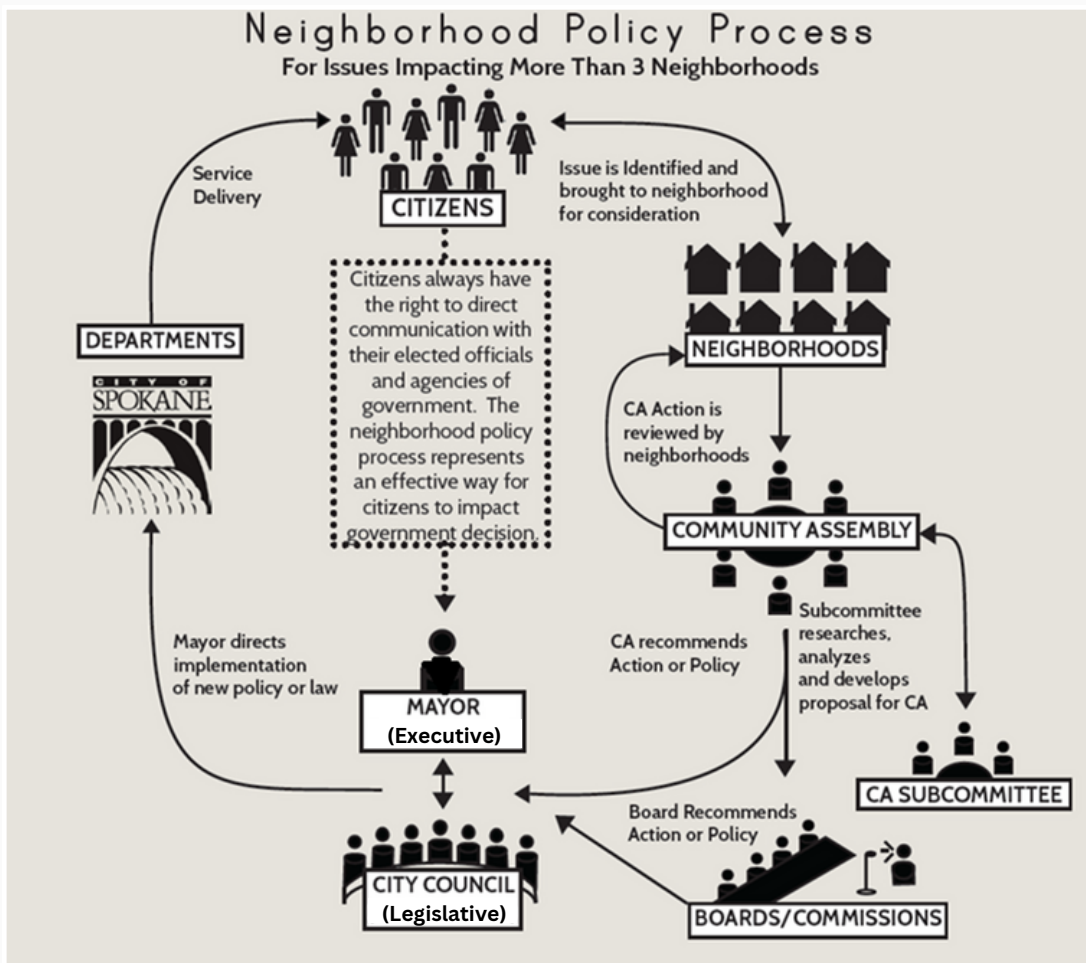
CITY COUNCIL PRESIDENT
