The Public is Invited to Learn More About the Construction of Improvements to US 2 and Deer Heights Road

Proposed development within the immediate area of US 2 and Deer Heights Road has facilitated the need for improvements to this intersection. Through the land use process, the intersection was studied and it was determined the best solution for accommodating the increase in traffic would be the installation of a roundabout at US 2 and Deer Heights Road. Construction on the roundabout is expected to begin

in late April to early May. We will have displays of the design along with the proposed traffic control measures and construction staging. There will not be a formal presentation, so please drop by any time between 4:00 pm and 6:00 pm. Staff from the design-consulting firm of David Evans and Associates, Inc. along with WSDOT staff will be on hand to provide information and answer questions.


