NOTICE OF CITY COUNCIL PUBLIC HEARING PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO SPOKANE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 17C.130.310 INDUSTRIAL ZONE FENCES (Proposed Ordinance No. C35635)

Notice is hereby given that there will be a public hearing before the City of Spokane City Council on <u>June 25, 2018 at</u> <u>6:00 p.m.</u> in the City Council Chambers, Lower Level of City Hall, 808 West Spokane Falls Boulevard, Spokane, Washington, to receive public testimony on a proposed ordinance to amend Section 17C.130.310, Industrial Zone Fences, of the Spokane Municipal Code. This amendment has been brought forward in response to a request for approval of an electric fence security system in an area of the City zoned Light Industrial; a use that is currently prohibited outside areas zoned Heavy Industrial. The proposal would permit electric fence security systems to be installed around non-residential outdoor storage areas in Light Industrial zones. The proposal also amends the conditions under which electric fence security systems may be installed and operated in permitted zones including compliance with street frontage and screening when electric fence security systems are installed adjacent to or across a street or alley from a non-industrial zone, amending permitted hours of operation, and requiring solid surface fencing when installed within five feet of a pedestrian connection. The goal is to provide secure locations for businesses to operate and store equipment and merchandise outdoors while balancing the needs of and character of nearby, non-industrial uses.

Written comments and oral testimony at the public hearings for these proposed actions will be made part of the public record. Only the applicant, persons submitting written comments and persons testifying at a hearing may appeal the decision of the City Council.

NOTIFICATION OF CITY COUNCIL PRIOR TO INITIATING CERTAIN LITIGATION

Effective: June 13, 2018

DEPT 0500-18-01 / LGL 2018-0015

1.0 GENERAL

1.1 PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish a policy of notifying the City Council prior to initiating any nonemergency litigation where the City is plaintiff and outside counsel is retained.

This policy and procedure shall apply to the Office of City Attorney.

3.0 REFERENCES

4.0 DEFINITIONS

5.0 POLICY

Except in emergency situations, as determined by the City Attorney, the City Attorney or his/her designee shall notify the City Council sufficiently in advance of commencing any non-emergency civil litigation where the City is plaintiff and outside counsel is retained. The notification shall be provided sufficiently in advance to provide the City Council a reasonable time to consult with the City Attorney prior to commencing the litigation, if requested by the City Council.

6.0 PROCEDURE

Except in emergency situations, as determined by the City Attorney, the City Attorney or his/her designee shall notify the City Council President whenever the City Attorney intends to commence civil litigation in which the City will be plaintiff and outside counsel will be retained to represent the City. Following such notification, and if requested by the Council President, the City Attorney or his/her designee shall advise Council members in executive session prior to commencing such litigation.

7.0 RESPONSIBILITIES

The City Attorney shall administer this policy and procedure.
