This project consists of the rehabilitation of the existing Shiloh Hills Lift Station including submersible pumps, piping, valves, relocation of an owner provided generator canopy, fencing, natural gas fired generator with transfer switch, new electrical service, and associated electrical controls to support the function of the lift station.
