**RE: OPO #16-7, Notice of Ombudsman certifying completed Internal Affairs investigation**

This correspondence serves as notice the Office of Police Ombudsman ("OPO") has reviewed and certified Internal Affairs' ("IA") completed investigation into your concern as timely, thorough, and objective, pursuant to Spokane Municipal Code §04.32.030(F).

The scope of the investigation was specific to Inadequate Response by the Spokane Police Department, the Spokane County Sherriff's Department, and the Spokane Police Volunteer Citizen Officers. The following information aided in my determination:

1. Complainant arrived to the Public Safety Building without an appointment and requested to see someone from IA.
2. Complainant was notified by a Spokane Police Citizen Volunteer that no one was available in IA.
3. During the time of this complaint, the Ombudsman was participating with Internal Affairs in an interview of an officer and can attest that no one was available to contact the complainant from IA.
4. As there were demeanor concerns with the Volunteer Citizen and the Sheriff's Deputy, this complaint has been routed to their respective designated receiver of complaints -- Spokane County Sheriff's Office, Sgt Tim Hines at 509-477-6626, and the Spokane Police Volunteer Citizen Officer Manager, Marissa Butler at 509-625-4045, for follow up.

If you have any follow up questions regarding this matter, I am happy to schedule a closing meeting at your convenience.
