

Special Loading Zone

Guidelines

Spokane Municipal Code:

<u>SMC 16A.61.5703</u> provides for the creation of a Special Loading Zone (SLZ) in a regular parking space by temporary sign(s), barricade(s), or other approved devices.

Usage:

Special Loading Zones are for commercial vehicles and vehicles engaged in services in conjunction with utilities, construction and maintenance, and special parking zones. The permits are for use by official vehicles, clearly identifiable news media vehicles and clearly identified vehicles of charitable nonprofit service organizations and vehicles qualifying as Entertainment Parking District Privilege as provided in <u>SMC 16A.04.100(G)</u>. Food trucks, taxis, and mobile vendors are NOT eligible.

These are strictly enforced by the City of Spokane. Failure to follow the usage guidelines may result in cancellation of the permit and issuance of a parking ticket.

If someone has parked in the space you have reserved and you are unable to park there, please call 311.

How to Purchase:

Daily, monthly, quarterly, and annual SLZ permits may be obtained in person at the 3rd floor of City Hall, Development Services Center during regular business hours. Permits may also be purchased online at www.spokanepermits.org.

Fees:

Commercial/Service Vehicles:

Daily Permit: \$15/space daily; 72-hour advance notice required

Monthly Permit: \$125 Quarterly Permit: \$350

News Media:

Annual Permit: \$1000 Additional Permits: \$500

Charitable/Non-profit*:

Monthly Permit: \$60 Additional Permit: \$60

*Maximum of two permits at discounted charitable/non-profit rate.
