



Temporary Parking Permit

Revised 12.11.23

Municipal Code

A temporary parking permit (TPP) allows parking in any area designated by the parking permit and may contain restrictions as deemed necessary by the Parking Manager.

Overview

- A temporary parking permit is defined in SMC 16A.06.090.
- A temporary parking permit is ONLY valid the same day of purchase.
- The permit is digital and connected to the license plate number provided.
- A temporary parking permit allows the permit holder to:
 - park in an on-street paid parking space (2,4, All Day) without paying a device or app.
 - unlimited movement from space to space within the [Paid Parking Zone](#).
 - park in an on-street paid parking space and stay beyond the posted time limits (2/4) without moving for the day.
- A temporary parking permit is NOT valid in non-paid parking spaces.
- Food trucks, taxis/cabs and mobile vendors are NOT eligible for temporary parking permits.

Costs and Fees

Temporary Parking Permit - \$15 per day + cost of lost paid parking revenue (\$18.70)

Use/Guidelines:

1. Permits are only valid for on-street paid parking spaces (2,4, All-Day).
2. Permit holders must follow stopping, standing, parking, and loading regulations in the Spokane Municipal Code (SMC 16A.05) as well as general permit guidelines (SMC 16A.06.010).
3. The license plate number provided *must* match what is listed on the vehicle registration. Please be sure the plate matches exactly. Do not put any spaces between the letters and numbers. Know if your plate has a “Zero” or an “O” and enter accordingly.

Parking permits are strictly enforced by the City of Spokane. Failure to follow the items above may result in the issuance of a parking ticket.
