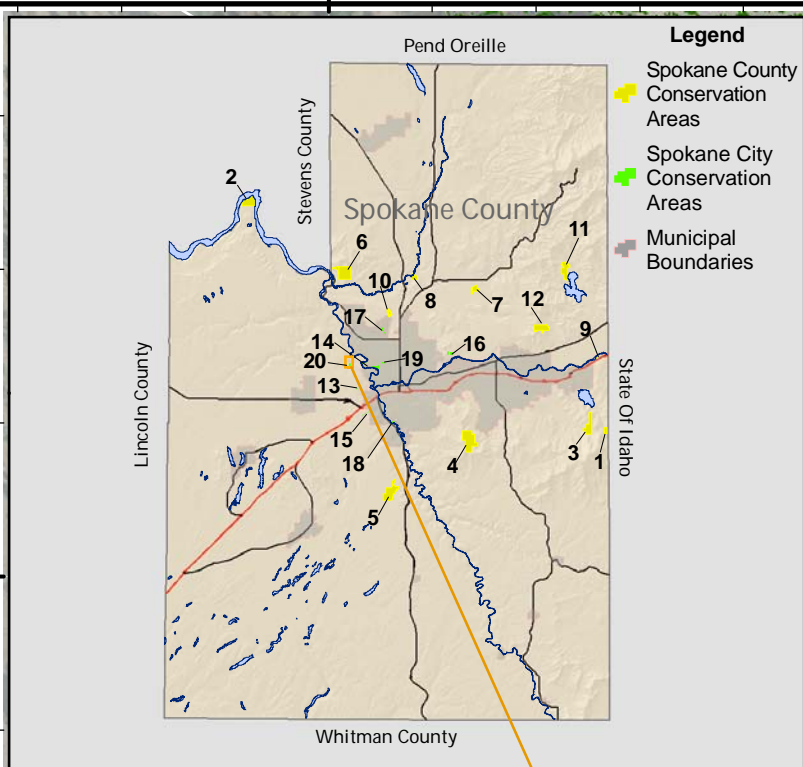

- Turn left at 2nd Avenue
- Continue 1 mile on 2nd Ave./Sunset Blvd.
- Turn right (north) on Government Way, drive for 4.5 miles
- Government Way turns into Trails Road near Riverside State Park
- The property entrance is on the south side of Trails Road (left) across from the 'T' intersection with Aubrey L. White Parkway

Note: There is no parking available along Government Way or Trails Road; please use caution when visiting the Conservation Area.
