- Minor Structure Repair

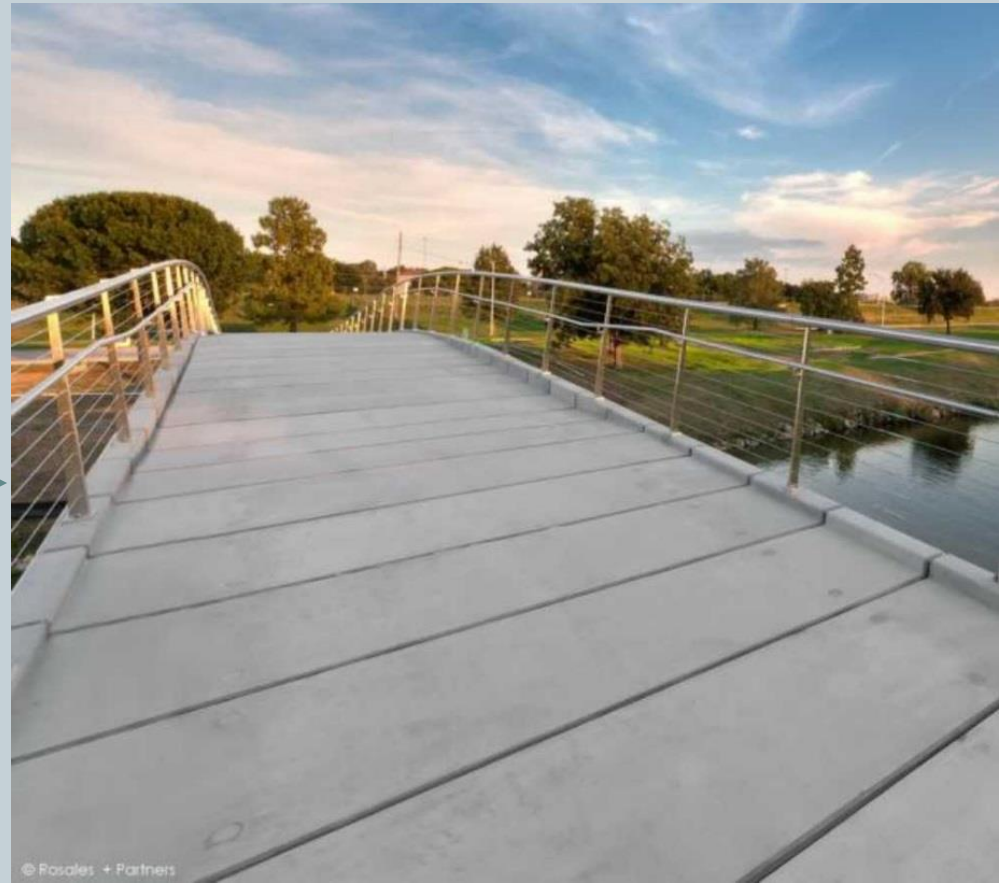

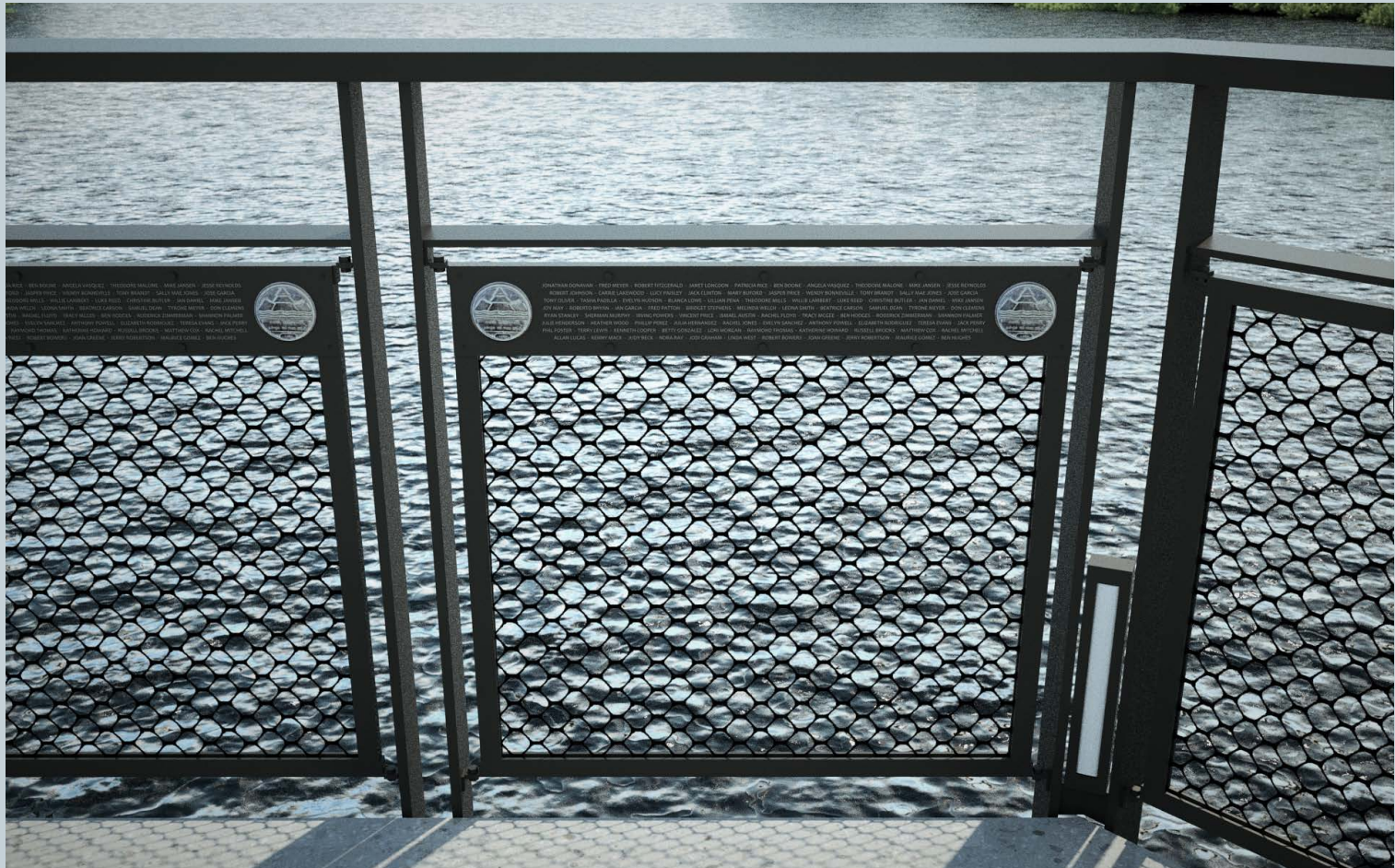

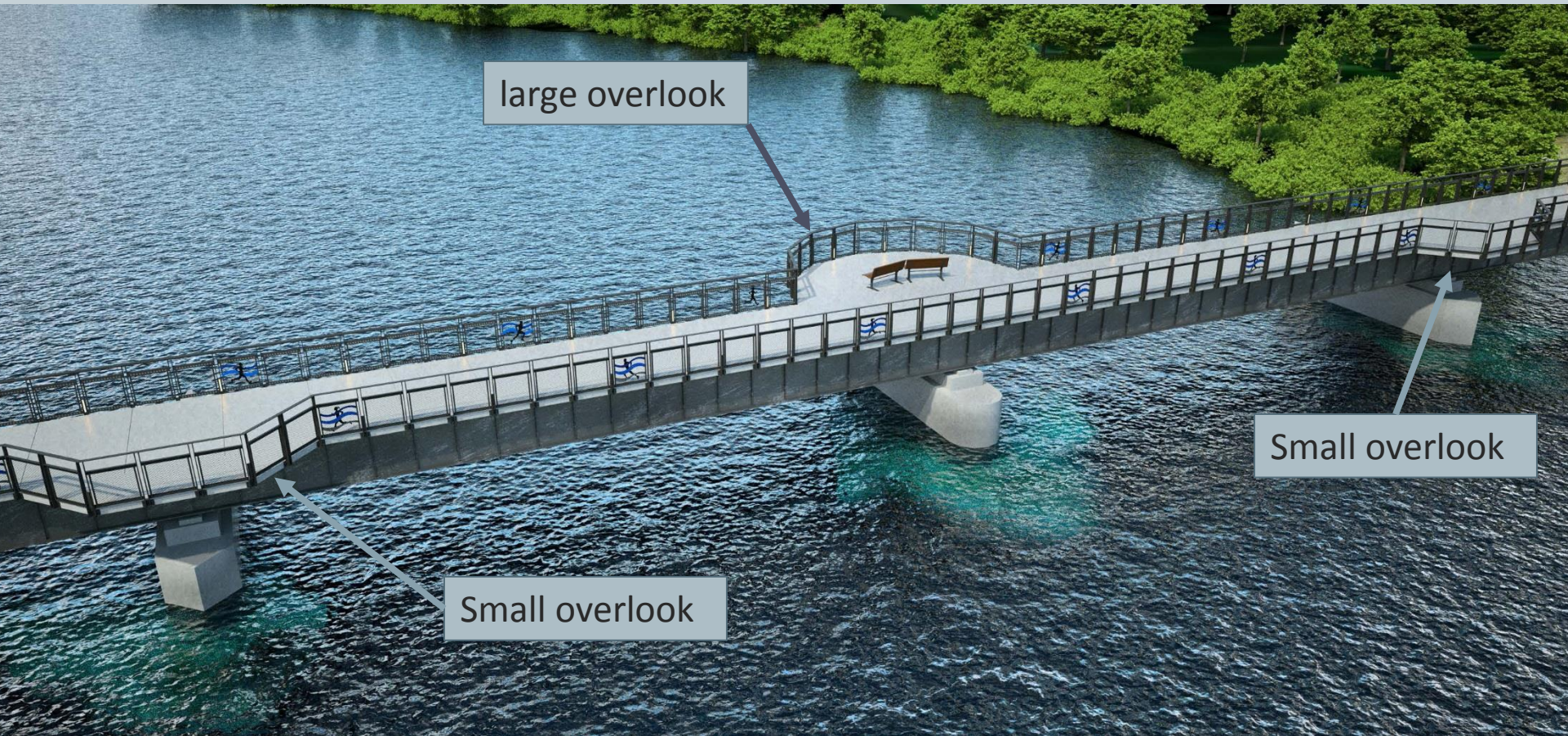
