







# COVID-19 Procedures – PHASE 2 City of Spokane - New Year's Eve Drive-In Fireworks Celebration

### **Event Overview:**

The City of Spokane Parks and Recreation, Spokane County, Spokane Indians and Spokane Public Schools are partnering to bring the community a safe and socially distant New Year's Eve celebration by offering a geographically dispersed "drive-in" fireworks experience. Presenting organizations are utilizing previously developed fireworks plans and redirecting resources from cancelled New Year's Eve activities at Riverfront Park and Avista Stadium due to COVID-19. Four separate fireworks displays lasting approximately 8 minutes long will be provided and strategically positioned in the community targeting multiple Spokane neighborhoods. The community will be provided recommended parking locations for each location and additional COVID-19 guidelines and requirements.

## **EVENT PROTOCOLS – ALL LOCATIONS**

#### **Event Protocol and Procedures**

- 1. Event staff and security personnel are required to wear face masks and gloves at all times.
- 2. Staff members with COVID-like symptoms, which include fever, sore throat, cough, loss smell/taste, gastrointestinal issues not caused by another condition; or has been in contact with COVID-19 positive person should not be reporting to work.
- 3. Parking lots will open one and a half hours prior to the event to discourage tailgating or other preevent functions.
- 4. Vehicles will be positioned in lots to ensure a minimum of 10' distance between each vehicle is achieved (e.g. every other parking spot).
- 5. Guests must remain in their vehicles at all times unless using the restroom.
- 6. Vehicular signage will be placed at the entrance to each location outlining social distancing guidelines for attendees.
- 7. Upon entrance, security personnel will place a flyer under each vehicle's windshield wiper, facing inward, outlining event-specific COVID safety procedures.
- 8. Each parking lot will be staffed with approximately ten fifteen licensed security personnel and two police officers to position vehicles appropriately, provide traffic mitigation support, remind

- guests of mask mandate protocols, and to ensure the safety and security of attendees throughout the duration of the event.
- 9. A minimum of four portable restrooms equipped with hand sanitizing units will be available at each location and spaced to support social distancing.
