Closed Case Summary

INCIDENT SYNOPSIS

The complainant had reported a vehicle prowl and attempted to contact the investigations supervisor for his area to inquire as to the status of his case. He called the supervisor several times, leaving messages.

COMPLAINT

The complainant contacted the OPO to complain against the supervisor for inadequate response, saying that he never received any kind of call back.

INVESTIGATION

Internal affairs investigators contacted the investigative supervisor, who advised that he had attempted to call the complainant back. He was unable to leave a message for the complainant as the complainant's voice mailbox was full and no further messages could be left. The investigative supervisor provided documenting four instances when he attempted to contact the complainant. The IA investigator attempted to call the complainant as well, but his voice mailbox was full and a message was not able to be left.

ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSION

As the investigative supervisor attempted to contact the complainant, and due to the issue with the voice mailbox, this complaint was determined to be unfounded.
