INCIDENT SYNOPSIS

A Neighborhood Resource Officer (NRO) was working a residence as a chronic nuisance. He contacted the homeowner and was discussing the issue with her. The homeowner's son, the complainant in this complaint, came out of the house and the NRO addressed some of the behaviors by the complainant that was contributing to the chronic nuisance.

COMPLAINT

The complainant alleges the NRO would not let him speak or give his side of the story.

INVESTIGATION

Internal Affairs reviewed the incident and determined that the NRO was actively working the residence I question as a chronic nuisance. The body worn camera depicted the interaction between the NRO and the complainant. The demeanor of the NRO was in keeping with SPD policy and it was determined that his demeanor was appropriate.

ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSION

This complaint was closed as an inquiry as the allegation of demeanor did not allege any policy violation in this incident.
