Closed Case Summary

INCIDENT SYNOPSIS

The complainant contacted the Office of the Police Ombudsman at this mother's request to report he was being followed by the Patrol Anti-Crime Team which he thought was unfair.

COMPLAINT

The complainant alleged he was being followed by the Patrol Anti-Crime Team because he had stolen cars in the past, and was a user of illicit drugs. He contended that he is now clean and sober and is no longer involved in criminal activity.

INVESTIGATION

An investigation into this complaint revealed the complainant was arrested for Attempt to Elude a Police Vehicle, and several other charges on 6/25/19 by the Spokane Police Department. After an objective review of the complainant's original complaint it was determined the officers in question hadn't committed any policy violations. The concerns brought forth by the complainant were identified as approved pro-active police tactics to address habitual offenders.

ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSION

Based on the above analysis of the facts of this incident it was determined no policy violations occurred, therefore this incident was classified as an Inquiry.
