## Closed Case Summary

### INCIDENT SYNOPSIS

Complainant has made numerous calls to crime check/911 regarding a neighboring drug house. On 08/05/20 and officer and supervisor responded to discuss the details of the most recent incident. When the officer asked "Who has lived here longer?" The complainant believed their issue was not being taken seriously and requested a supervisor.

### COMPLAINT

The complainant alleged that the police department has not been responsive for their calls for service. Additionally the complainant believed the officer's question regarding the time the neighbor had lived in their apartment indicated a demeanor that was dismissive and rude.

### INVESTIGATION

The investigation showed numerous calls for service by complainant, all of which indicated police response and follow up. Additionally, there was no indication that the officer's question was rude, impolite, or out of the norm the appropriate investigation.

### ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSION

The allegation that complainant's calls to police have not garnered police response has been classified as an inquiry. The demeanor allegation has been administratively suspended (f), as all reasonable investigative leads were exhausted and no evidence of wrongdoing was uncovered.
