Allegation: Inadequate Response

Chain of Command Finding: Inquiry

Final Discipline: Closed

INCIDENT SYNOPSIS:

Complainant called 9-1-1 to report a person gained access into secured area of a residential building. A short time later, the complainant reported the person was gone. 9-1-1 broadcast the incident and officers checked the area but did not locate a suspect. The caller was not contacted at the conclusion of the call.

COMPLAINT:

The complainant alleged that officers should have contacted them in person during the call for service.

INVESTIGATION:

The investigator interviewed the complainant, reviewed the 9-1-1 calls, dispatch records, and interviewed 9-1-1 staff.

ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSION:

The investigation concluded the employee acted appropriately. 9-1-1 staff confirmed that given the circumstances and information, and the concern was no longer occurring, a broadcast to the patrol group would be consistent with standard dispatch procedures.
