## Closed Case Summary

### INCIDENT SYNOPSIS:

A community member stated that while travelling through a school zone they witnessed a Spokane Police car following another citizen vehicle through the zone four miles over the speed limit.

### COMPLAINT:

The Complainant did not see the police car stop the first driver and believe that the police officer was driving excessively and placing people in danger.

### INVESTIGATION:

Internal Affairs reviewed the documentation provided by the complainant. There was no identifying information provided by the complainant. It was impossible to identify the involved officer. There were few details describing the even or persons lives being in jeopardy. It was noted in the investigation, that misalignment in the complainant's speedometer could have affected the complainant's perception of vehicle speeds. Complainant described the officer as, "casually speed(ing) through a school zone."

### ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSION:

The investigation was unable to identify a specific officer or policy violation based on the information provided.
