## Closed Case Summary

### INCIDENT SYNOPSIS:

On 06/02/22, Internal Affairs initiated follow up with the complainant reference a demeanor complaint.

The complainant called 911 reference her landlord's sister and 3 men going to her house and threatening her about an eviction notice she had been served.

### COMPLAINT:

The complainant stated the officers were rude, disrespectful and she wasn't satisfied with the outcome. The complainant claimed the officers didn't know the laws surrounding the situation (Landlord/Tenant) and defended the harassers the complainant had called about.

### INVESTIGATION:

Internal Affairs talked to the complainant.

Internal Affairs watched the BWC footage of both officers that responded to this call.

### ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSION:

It was determined there were no policy violations. A report number was provided to the complainant by the officers. The officers went out of their way to give numerous stickers to the complainant's young child that was present. Both officers were polite, professional, and reasonably accurate with current Landlord/Tenant law. The police response was in line with the department's Mission, Vision, and Values.

The complainant thanked Internal Affairs for the follow up and speaking with her.

This investigation is classified as an INQUIRY.
