INCIDENT SYNOPSIS:

Officers responded to the complainant's residence just before midnight looking for a wanted male that was staying at their house. The complainant alleged officers trampled some plants in their front yard and were overly loud in their approach.

The complainant slept through this incident and got the information from their son, which is who the police spoke with.

COMPLAINT:

The complainant stated she felt the officers were overly aggressive in their approach at her house.

INVESTIGATION:

Internal Affairs investigated the allegations. Internal Affairs spoke with the complainant, reviewed all associated reports and body-worn camera footage.

ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSION:

Internal Affairs reviewed the body-worn camera footage of the responding officers. The complainant was not a witness to the allegation of being overly aggressive and loud. The body-worn camera footage disproved this allegation.

This case was classified as an Inquiry.
