INCIDENT SYNOPSIS:

Spokane Police officers responded to a vehicle vs. scooter collision. The collision investigation concluded, and the proper reports were filed.

COMPLAINT:

The complainant alleged the responding officer failed to get all the information about the collision and thought the vehicle driver should have been cited for being at fault and the details in the collision were incorrect. The complainant spoke with an SPD supervisor about the collision and mistake on the report, and then wanted to make a complaint about the supervisor's demeanor.

INVESTIGATION:

Spokane Police Department Internal Affairs investigated this complaint by reviewing the police reports and body worn camera videos.

ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSION:

Spokane Police Department Internal Affairs determined the officers' action were appropriate given the information they had at the time. The complainant was contacted and advised of the actions being found as appropriate, and they advised the wished to drop the complaint. This case was closed as an inquiry.
