INCIDENT SYNOPSIS:

Spokane Police officers responded to a reported assault involving multiple involved parties, including minors. Officers contacted multiple involved parties, some of which were uncooperative, and determined there was not probable cause to charge anyone with a crime.

COMPLAINT:

The complainant alleged that officers failed to document injuries to one of the parties, a minor. The complainant also alleged that officers were discourteous to her and officers failed to contact their supervisor when she requested.

INVESTIGATION:

The investigator interviewed the complainant. The investigator photographed the minor's injuries, then reviewed officers' reports and body worn camera footage.

ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSION:

The investigation determined there were no policy violations, but identified several areas of improvement for some of the officers on the call. Those officers were given informal counseling by their supervisor.
