INCIDENT SYNOPSIS:

Spokane Police officers responded to an auto-pedestrian collision in a parking lot. Two pedestrians were struck by a vehicle. Officers investigated the collision and determined there was no sufficient evidence to charge the driver with a crime.

COMPLAINT:

The complainant was one of the pedestrians struck. She alleged the officer should have charged the driver with a crime. She also alleged that information in the collision report was inaccurate.

INVESTIGATION:

The investigator interviewed the complainant and the officer. The investigator attempted to locate witnesses to the incident. The investigator reviewed police reports and body worn camera footage.

ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSION:

The Spokane PD chain of command determined the officer's decision not to file criminal charges was correct. The collision report contained inaccurate information that was not relevant to the charging decision, but was incorrect nonetheless.
