Responded to 3918 E. 4th reference a suicidal male with a gun. A subject called in an advised he was armed with a .357 handgun and was going to kill himself. He advised he had already gone outside and fired a round off to make sure the gun worked. The subject was extremely intoxicated and very uncooperative. Officers arrived on scene and established a plan. They moved up utilizing a vehicle for cover and ballistic shield. There was also an officer with a bean bag shotgun in case impact munitions became needed. Officers were able to safely verbally deescalate the subject and get him out of the residence where he was taken to Sacred Heart to get the help he admittedly advised he needed.



Source of 2014 Complaints*



Unfounded - When the investigation discloses that the alleged act(s) did not occur or did not involve department personnel.

Exonerated - When the investigation discloses that the alleged act occurred, but that the act was justified, lawful and/or proper.

Not Sustained - When the investigation discloses that there is insufficient evidence to sustain the complaint or fully exonerate the employee.

Sustained - When the investigation discloses sufficient evidence to establish that the act occurred and that it constituted misconduct.

Training Failure - Deficiency in training was the cause of the alleged act.

Closed Due to Mediation - Is an alternative to the investigation, adjudication and disciplinary process.



2014 Deadly Force Incidents

March 2014---Investigative Reviews Total: 2

March 26th, 2014---Director of Strategic Initiatives Tim Schwering and Internal Affairs Lt. Lundgren responded to 1527 W. Grace Avenue after an Officer Involved Shooting. Officers were investigating the suspect's involvement in a series of Armed Robberies at the time of the shooting. Sgt. Braun will be the lead on the Deadly Force Review after the SIRR Team investigation and Prosecutorial Review are completed.

COMPSTAT

The Spokane Police Department conducts a weekly COMPSTAT meeting each Tuesday morning. SPD leadership come together to examine current crime data and develop focused strategies for reducing crime throughout each neighborhood in the city. The results of previous strategies are discussed and approaches are adjusted for maximum impact. Starting in May, SPD Internal Affairs will provide a monthly report detailing complaint data, officer collisions, and vehicle pursuits. This will allow department leadership to monitor any trends in the measured areas on a regular basis.

Continuing Education for Investigators:

SPD Internal Affairs consists of two Investigative Sergeants, one Lieutenant Investigative Supervisor, and one Administrative Assistant. All commissioned staff members were recently transferred to the unit. The Spokane Police Department has committed to providing a high level of training to those who are responsible for conducting Internal and Sensitive Investigations.
