Reviewer comment:

Sgt. Vigesaa's report was delayed in beng submitted due to a technical glitch. This however allowed more time to pass, and during this time, the JTTF found two handguns in Graves' residence that could have been what the complainants heard rather than bottle rockets on the night of this incident.

With the reports of shots being fired on the night of this incident, the officers were exercising proper caution in not leaving cover to approach a non-compliant suspect. The use of the bean-bags rounds was reasonable under these circumstances and within Departmental Policy and Procedure. The use of multiple rounds was justified as Graves did not comply with the officer's commands after the initial bean-bag rounds were deployed.

Use of Force Additional

On 01-27-13 at 2106hrs, Ofc's responded to 6510 N Elmhurst for a Domestic Violence call. The complainant was a child who was reporting her "Dad is freaking out" and "Hitting mom". At 2108hrs the complainant heard gunshots and at 2110hrs she reported that "dad shot mom".

Ofc's arrived onscene and set up containment with contact/arrest teams.

At 2111hrs we were being advised that the Dad was the only subject in the house and that the mother and two children including the complainant were out of the house and down the street. Ofc's were sent to contact them for details. The mother and children were separated and were in different locations hiding and seeking help in the neighborhood. While Ofc's were trying to locate the three subjects, the male was shutting off all the lights inside the house and closing the drapes.

At 2121hrs, a male later identified as suspect-Richard Graves came out onto the front upstairs covered porch. Graves was very angry and was yelling at us to "Fucking do it" while waving his arms to the side and sticking his chest out at us. Graves was saying something regarding "The Feds" and asking if the Feds sent us to him. It was apparent by Graves' behavior and statements/language that he was highly intoxicated and/or using drugs.

Graves paced back and forth on his front porch while we negotiated with him from below and behind cover. Graves was a large man who was wearing jeans and a T-Shirt that covered his waist area. Graves was eventually talked into coming downstairs and outside to talk with us. He went back inside and came out a basement man door off the driveway. Graves continued with his aggressive statements and slowly walked out to the edge of his driveway near the street. Graves was consistently being given clear instructions and at this point "To slowly get down on the ground". Graves refused to get on the ground and was challenging us to why we were there and why he had to get on the ground.

An arrest/contact team was moving up on Graves at this point and took over clear instructions for graves to get on the ground. Graves was angry and refused to get on the ground. He was flailing his arms around as he yelled at officers, and his waist area was still concealed by his T-Shirt. It wasn't safe for officers to continue to approach him with the knowledge that he had just fired a gun, was non-compliant with us and unknown for sure if there was anyone else still inside his home.

Ofc Kernkamp had an Exact Impact Munition 12 gauge Bean Bag shotgun with him in the contact team. Ofc Kernkamp fired 1 Bean Bag round at Graves that hit him directly in the belly button. This impact would normally cause a person to drop to the ground but Graves slowly turned to the contact team and continued to challenge them. Clear instructions for Graves to "Get on the Ground" were consistently being given to Graves but Graves refused to get on the ground. It was still unknown why Graves was refusing to get on the ground. Was he planning on fighting with us? Was he planning on pulling out a weapon when we got closer?

Ofc Kernkamp fired a 2nd bean bag round which struck Graves in the left buttocks area. Graves started to bend over and go down but stood back up yelling at officers. Ofc Kernkamp fired a 3rd bean bag round which just missed Graves followed by a 4th round that struck him on the left side of his lower back area. The movement of the team along with bean bag rounds and orders for Graves to get on the ground were successful in getting Graves to start getting down on the ground on his own and divert any potential assaults he may have been planning.

Graves was detained without further incident and placed in the rear of a patrol car. Graves wasn't injured other than the contact abrasions from the bean bag rounds. Graves refused to be seen by

onsite medics and was transported to Deaconess after learning there was PC for City Assault DV, Mal Mis and Interfering w/Reporting.

I contacted Graves at Deaconess. When I walked into his examination room he was respectfully talking with officers and telling them he respects us and supports us. I introduced myself to Graves and asked him how he was doing. Graves said he was fine and ready to leave the hospital. He was cordial and asked me why we shot him with bean bags. I explained to him the chain of events from our point of view and what we were responding to. When I got to the point about shots being fired he said "I shot off bottle rockets from the back deck". When I got to the point of him coming out on the front porch and telling us to do it, he leaned his head back and said "Oh Ya, your absolutely correct", "I fucked up", "I would've shot me too". Graves continuously apologized from this point on. Graves said he had a lot to drink this evening and agreed that this affected his decisions. I observed the three bean bag impact abrasions on Graves and Cpl Griffin photographed them. I also observed a slight abrasion on Graves' right cheek which is consistent with prone handcuffing. While Graves was being photographed, I asked him about his several white supremacist tattoo's. Graves said he used to be with the Hells Angels and Hammerskins and also lived with Richard Butler in Hayden Idaho. He just moved back to Spokane after being in prison for shooting a subject in Tacoma and going back to Missouri to get his life in order. He said he's been in Spokane for less than one week and his criminal behavior is over. I thanked Graves for his openness and told him I was leaving. Graves put his hand out for me to shake and I shook his hand and left.

No handguns were found that evening and the wife said she didn't believe there were any guns in the house. It should be noted that the Spokane JTTF served a search warrant at Graves residence the following week and found two handguns.

On 01/27/2013 at about 2108 hours I responded to the area of 6501 N. Elmhurst on the report of a d.v. with a weapon. A juvenile female, #2 was calling 911 stating that "dad is hitting mom". She also stated that dad said that he was going to kill mom. She indicated that she had heard gunshots. She told 911 that she had left the house and was going to a friend's home.

She reported that her mom's name is Darralyn Lasater and she has a 16 yr old brother that is also at the home.

While enroute radio advised that the brother had called in and was with the mother, outside of the house. They were waiting for police contact a few blocks to the north at Elmhurst/Holyoke.

I responded to Elmhurst/Holyoke while other Officers responded to the residence.

When I arrived at Elmhurst/Holyoke I located Darralyn Lasater and her son #2 Lasater was crying and appeared upset. I spoke to Lasater while Ofc. Gobble interviewed #2

According to Lasater, she had not been shot and was not injured. Lasater told me that her boyfriend's name is Richard L. Graves #4b She said that they have been in a dating relationship for the past 14 years and they have one child together. She stated that they live together at 6501 N. Elmhurst with their daughter #2 and her son #2

Lasater told me that she and Graves had been out drinking at a bar earlier in the evening. She said that she had about three alcoholic drinks. She could not remember the name of the bar, but it is by the Safeway on Francis. She stated that she was ready to leave the bar and told Graves she was leaving. She said that when they went to leave the bar, Graves was mad at her and threw a trash can lid at the car. She said that she was in the car and the lid did not hit her or the car. She told me that she then drove home, leaving Graves at the bar. She was not sure what time this was.

She said that she drove home and fell asleep on the couch in the living room. She told me that the next thing she knew Graves was slapping her in the face and yelling at her. She said that he

slapped her at least once on the left side of her face. She stated that he was yelling at her and calling her names for leaving him at the bar. She could not remember the exact names. She said that she was reaching for her cell phone to call police, when Graves grabbed the phone and threw it on the floor. He then stomped on the phone, breaking it. Lasater said that she was scared of Graves, so she ran out of the house. She then found #2 a few blocks away and stayed with him until police arrived.

She told me that when she left the house she heard several popping sounds coming from the house. She told me that she does not believe that there are any firearms in the house.

I asked Lasater if Grave's had threatened her in any way. She told me that Grave's did not threaten her.

I looked at Lasater's face and could not see any visible injuries.

Officers onscene at 6501 N. Elmhurst had taken Graves into custody while I was interviewing Lasater. See other Officer's reports for more information.

Ofc. Madsen located and interviewed #2

After Graves was taken into custody I returned to the residence with Lasater and her children. She picked up a cell phone from the coffee table and said that this was the phone that Graves broke. The cushions on the couch were moved around and it appeared that a struggle had occurred. I looked at the phone and the screen of the phone was shattered. I would estimate the value of the phone to be about \$200. I photographed the phone and living room.

Based on the evidence and information available I found that there is p.c. to arrest Graves for City Assault D.V., City Malicious Mischief D.V., and Interfering with the reporting of D.V.

I provided Lasater a crime victim's card with the incident number.

Ofc. Eckersley placed the damaged phone on property.

Graves was later transported to jail by Ofc. Daddato where he was booked.

On 1/27/13 at 2012 hours I responded to 6501 N. Elmhurst reference **#2** (8 yrs old) calling in stating her dad was assaulting her mom.

While units were en route radio advised that the complainant heard gunshots, and that her Dad had shot her mom. **#2** then ran out of the house.

Initially, upon arrival it was unknown where mom, daughter or dad was. However shortly thereafter it was determined mom and daughter had escaped the house safely and the dad, Richard Graves, had fired a gun inside the house.

Soon after, I saw movement in the windows, the drapes were being closed and the lights in the house were turned off. Units talking to the mom and daughter advised Richard was alone in the house.

Within five minutes Richard came outside on the upper level of his residence. He was obviously intoxicated. His speech was slurred and was screaming about how the FBI is following him up to Washington State. He denied any wrong doing. However he repeatedly told the Police to "come and get me." Due to the distance and tactical advantages that Richard had it was not safe for the Police to approach him, and leave all points of cover.

I observed Richard to be an extremely large male. I would estimate he weighed 250 lbs of muscle, nearing six feet tall. It was obvious he was in very good shape. He was also very angry. He started walking out to the patrol cars yelling and screaming. At the edge of his driveway he refused to get down on the ground.

I was armed with .12 gauge Bean Bag round, an Exact Impact Munition. Ofc. Valdez assisted me in a 2 person loading drill. My .12 gauge firearm has a orange for end and an orange stock, with the words "LESS LETHAL" clearly marked on it.

After Richard turned around and faced Officers, he refused to get on the ground. I felt it was not safe for Officers to get any closer with Richard while he was still standing. Although he had complied to verbal commands to come out, he would not get on the ground and would not face away from Officers. If Officers approached him face to face it would have been an instant confrontation. I

also feared he was going to run back into his house. And at this time it was unknown if Richard was still armed with a firearm or not.

To assist Officers approaching Richard. I fired four rounds at Richard. The initial round struck him directly in the belly button. This forced him to turn, in a desired direction. I then fired another round, hitting him on his left buttocks/thigh area. This round caused him to bend over as officers ordered him to the ground. Richard then stood up. As I was approaching him, closing distance, nearing 30 yds, he turned to look at approaching officers, causing my 3rd round to skim the small of his back. He then turned and looked at Officers approaching who were getting within 20 feet from him. I fired my last round, striking him in left side of the small of his back. This caused enough misdirection and confusion combined with approaching Officers that Richard was successfully proned out without any further incident. No Officers were hurt or involved in any altercation as they took Richard into custody.

No weapons were found on his persons. At this time it was unknown if there were any injured persons inside the house. I assisted in clearing the house. There were no other injured persons inside.

It was determined that PC existed to charge Richard with City Assault DV. The gunshots were actually bottle rockets that he fired off.

He was transported to DMC and was cleared for booking by Dr. Deitzen.

At DMC I observed the initial round struck Richard directly in the belly button. The second round in the left thigh/buttocks area and the fourth round on the left side of his lower back. Cpl. Griffin photographed all the injuries.

At the hospital Richard said the bean bag rounds were effective however, he requested we "up the dose" on them because he said, "if I were to have started to shoot you, it would not have stopped me."

Richard has numerous Aryan tattoos on his body, including a swastika on his chest, and lightning bolts on his stomach. He was wearing Harley Davidson black leather boots and said he used to run with the Hells Angels. He said, "these are my shooting boots."

At the hospital Richard was very compliant and wanted to shake my hand. He apologized for being "drunk and stupid."

Ofc. Daddato transported Richard to SCJ and booked him.

On 01-27-13, at about 2111 hours, I responded to N. 6501 Elmhurst on a call from a child that "Dad was freaking out and hitting mom." Information in the call indicated that Dad had stated he was "going to kill mom." The caller stated he heard gunshots and that he was going to a friend's home.

Upon arrival, I took up a position on the N/W side of the house and lit up the back windows and doors of the house with spot lights. after several minutes, I heard a male voice yelling and then saw a W/M later identified as Richard Graves, on the front porch/balcony of the house leaning out and yelling at police out front. He kept yelling, "Do it! Do it!" and "Just do it!". He quickly disappeared out of my view but I could hear him continue to yell at police and I could hear officer(s) trying to talk to him.

Graves was taken into custody by other officers and transported to Deaconess Hospital for treatment from bean bag rounds. I took photographs of a damaged lens on a street light and then went to Deaconess Hospital and took photographs of Graves' injuries.

While taking photographs, Graves made several unsolicited statements. He stated we "need to up the load on them (beanbag rounds)" He went on to say, "No, seriously, you guys need to up the loads." He laughed at one point and said, "That was some cool shit."

Later, Graves stated he "Fucked up!" when reminded that he had come out on the front porch/balcony and yelled at officers to "Do it!" He apologized and said he was sorry and repeated, "I fucked up."

I responded to W. 2917 Houston to contact the juvenile female. Enroute, officers advised the mother and son were able to get out of the house but Richard was still inside the residence.

Upon arrival on Houston, I contacted a female who identified herself as #2 was extremely shaken over the incident and I could see her body was physically trembling. She made a statement that she was scared and wanted to know if her mother, brother and father were all alright. I explained to her that her mother and brother were fine and officers were in the process of contacting her father.

As #2 started talking, she continuously jumped around from one thing to another and it was hard for me to figure out what had occurred. After talking with #2 for several minutes, she appeared to calm down and was able to tell me the following.

Danika advised me that her family had recently moved to Spokane from the Mid West to be closer to family. Tonight, her mother and father had gone out to a bar. At about 2030 hrs., her mother arrived home from the bar upset and without her father. Her mother said she had gotten into an argument with her father and she had left him at the bar, after he had thrown something at the car. A short time after, her mother arrived home, she fell asleep on the living room couch. About 20 minutes later, her father arrived home extremely upset and intoxicated. He screamed obscenities at her mother calling her a "bitch" and a "Cunt", and then hit her.

#2 said she got scared, left the room, and starting putting on her tennis shoes because she felt things between her mother and father were getting out of hand. She heard a loud banging and her father scream, "I'm going to kill you." Her father's behavior frightened

I asked her what the loud bang had been. She told me that she didn't know because she was running out of the house. I asked her if she had seen her father with a gun tonight. She replied, "No."

#2 said she didn't want to go home because she was scared her mother and father would be upset with her for calling 911. I explained to her that no one was mad at her, she had done the right thing, and her mother was asking if she was alright.

I asked her if her mother & father into get into many arguments/fights and she replied, "No".

I contacted the homeowner who identified herself as being Janet Berry #4b. Berry said that she had been home when she heard someone pounding on her front door. She opened the door to see it was #2 was a new girl to the neighborhood and goes to school with one of her daughters. #2 was panicked and was talking a million miles a minute about her intoxicated father hitting her mother, she heard shots but she didn't see a gun, and she was scared for her mother. Berry said it was extremely hard for her to understand everything that #2 was telling her because when she asked her specific questions about why she thought her father had a gun, she couldn't answer.

#2 never mentioned anything to me about a firearm until I asked her if her father had owned a gun.

On 012713 at 2106 hours I responded to a report of an assault at the intersection of N Elmhurst and W Houston. The complainant initially stated her dad was freaking out and was hitting her mom. As I was responding the complainant stated dad was going to kill mom then stated she heard gunshots. The complainant was an eight year old female that had fled the residence prior to hearing gunshots. A second caller stated his dad had shot his mom the stated he and mom had fled the residence and dad was at home by himself.

I arrived first and took a position on the residence across the street to the west off the south west corner of the residence. I illuminated the front porch and side of the residence with my vehicle spotlights. I could see the silhouette of a person inside of the residence who appeared to be going room to room turning off the lights. As other Officers arrived the residence was contained.

Approximately ten minutes later the male, who was later identified as Richard Graves, exited the residence onto the south porch of the residence. I could see Graves appeared very agitated. Graves was throwing his hands in the air and stated several times "just fucking do it." I could hear Graves make the comments "did the FBI send you" and he appeared to be paranoid someone was after him. Officers to the east of my location, to the east of the residence made voice contact with Graves and he made his way from the porch down to the ground level in front of the residence.

Graves was being directed to walk out the driveway of the residence to the south. Myself along with other officers moved behind Graves to prevent his ability to reenter the residence due to the nature of the call and not knowing if he had any firearms inside of the residence. I could hear Officers giving Graves commands to get down on the ground and I saw he was not complying. Officer Kernkamp fired four bean bag rounds at Graves striking him in his upper torso. I saw Graves react to the bean bags however he still did not go to the ground as instructed. We continued to move toward Graves and he began to get onto his hands and knees. Once on the ground I placed Graves in handcuffs.

I checked Graves for any weapons on his person and found none. I advised Graves he was being detained while we investigate the report of an assault and I sat him in the back of a patrol vehicle. I was advised by Corporal McCollough that the female victim was not shot however there was PC for City Assault-DV. While detained handcuffed in the back of the patrol vehicle I advised Graves of his constitutional rights. Graves stated he understood his rights then invoked his rights and stated he
