#### **Summary:**

On 3-3-13 at approximately 1725, I heard some garbled radio traffic on channel 1 (north). The radio transmission sounded like a female in a struggle. Radio was able to determine that the transmission came from Officer Rosenthal's (#690) portable radio. Officer Rosenthal and Officer Voeller (#664) were on a DV call at 5313 N Regal #213.

The original call stated that the complainant, not at the scene, received a text message from "Angela", later determined to be Angela M Gray stating that she had been hit by her boyfriend, later determined to be Cabbie E Baruth #4b, and that he was not letting her leave the apartment.

When I arrived to the scene Officer Rosenthal advised me that she had placed Baruth in a Carotid hold but that Baruth did not loose consciousness at any time. Officer Voeller advised me that he attempted to apply a drive stun with his taser (no cartridge attached) but that the application did not have any affect because Baruth was able to knock the taser away from his body. Both officers showed me that couch that Baruth had landed on during the struggle. I saw that there was a screwdriver and a kitchen knife on the couch. Both officers stated that Baruth had lunged toward the couch as they attempted to gain control of him. I also saw numerous syringes inside the living room where the officers contacted Baruth.

It should be noted that the apartment building has a secured front door. Access can only be gained with a code or if another resident lets you into the building.

Neither officer had any injuries.

I contacted Gray. When I asked her if Baruth had fought with the officers she said, "He fought hardcore".

I contacted Baruth outside the apartment building as medics were treating him for using a large amount of methamphetamine. Baruth stated that he had been using methamphetamine for the past four days and estimated that he used 2 grams during the day leading up to his contact with law enforcement. When I asked him if he had fought with the police he said, "I tensed up, but they should have saw that I was in a bad way". I did not see any injuries to Baruth.

Officer Rosenthal stated in her report that radio had advised that Baruth had a confirmed felony warrant for his arrest prior to officers arriving to the scene. When Gray opened the apartment door Officer Rosenthal stated that Gray appeared to be scared and was talking very fast. Gray told the officers that her ex-boyfriend, Baruth, had stolen money from her to purchase methamphetamine. Gray also stated that Baruth had hit her, forced her to take methamphetamine, and was refusing to leave her apartment.

When Officer Rosenthal entered the apartment she saw that Baruth was pacing back and forth near a second floor window in the living room. Officer Rosenthal described Baruth as nervous, shaky, sweaty, and talking very fast. She could see that Baruth's hands were clenched and that her was shaking his head from side to side while stating that he would not talk to them. At one point it appeared to Officer Rosenthal that Baruth was looking past the officers and was possibly preparing to flee. Officer Rosenthal saw that the living room was cluttered and contained several metal objects, possibly knifes.

Officer Rosenthal feared that Baruth was going to become violent. She attempted to gain control of his left arm. She felt Baruth tighten his body as he pulled his left arm away from her. She then started to fall forward toward the couch along with Baruth and Officer Voeller. Officer Rosenthal used her right arm to apply a Carotid hold on Baruth to help gain control of him, prevent him from causing harm to the officers and Gray, and prevent him from gaining access to any potential weapons. Officer Rosenthal was able to maintain the Carotid hold even though she fell onto her left side on the couch. She fell onto her taser preventing her from gaining access to it. Baruth did not loose consciousness. Baruth stated that he could not breath and that he would comply but then failed to show his hands. Officer Rosenthal changed her Carotid hold on Baruth from her right arm to her left arm. She released the Carotid hold to assist Officer Voeller in placing Baruth into handcuffs. After Baruth was arrested Officer Rosenthal located a small black container on his person. The contents of the container later tested positive for methamphetamine.

Officer Voeller stated in his report that when he made contact with Gray at the front door to her apartment that she appeared to be scared. Her eyes were wide open and she could not sit still. She told Officer Voeller that Baruth had been hitting her and that he would kill her if she attempted to make him leave. Gray also confirmed that Baruth was still in the apartment. When Officer Voeller entered the apartment he saw a male inside that he immediately recognized as Baruth from a previous jail booking photo. Baruth made eye contact with Officer Voeller and then "went straight to the far west wall". Baruth started walking back and forth near the west wall of the living room. He placed his hands into his pockets briefly. As he took his hands out of his pockets he looked at Officer Voeller and told him to get away. Officer Voeller could see a cigarette lighter in one of Baruth's hands. Baruth had another unknown item in his other hand but Officer Voeller could not clearly see the object because Baruth's hand was balled into a fist. Baruth had bladed his stance "like a fighting stance of a boxer". Baruth then told Officer Voeller that if he touched him he would jump out of the window. Officer Voeller then described Baruth as agitated and that he was clenching his jaw and tensing his body.

Officer Voeller stated that Baruth started looking past him toward the couch and the area behind him. Officer Voeller looked down at the couch and saw open blade knifes, screwdrivers, and other objects that could be used as weapons. Officer Voeller stated that he did not feel safe and was also concerned for Officer Rosenthal's safety. Officer Voeller reached for Baruth but he pulled away backward. Officer Voeller was able to grab hold of Baruth's right arm. Baruth immediately attempted to pull his arm away as he lunged forward toward the couch. Officer Voeller again feared that Baruth was possibly attempting to gain access to one of the weapons on the couch. Baruth landed face down on the couch. Baruth's right arm was down to his side but his left arm was underneath his body. Baruth was either laying on top of a knife and screwdriver or was within close reach of those potential weapons.

Officer Voeller described Baruth as displaying an extreme amount of strength was preventing officers from gaining control of his arms. Baruth was "bucking" his body upward and was also attempting to stand up by pressing his feet on the floor. Officer Voeller delivered a single knee strike to Baruth's left in an attempt to prevent Baruth from getting to his feet. Baruth was not able to get to his feet but started roll his body around in an attempt to get away from the police. As Baruth continued to attempt to pull away from the police Officer Voeller's portable radio was knocked away from his uniform preventing him from calling for assistance. At one point Officer Voeller was able to attach one side of his handcuffs to Baruth's right wrist but Baruth was then able to pull his right wrist away. Baruth continued to "violently" struggle and now had another possible weapons attached to his right wrist.

Officer Voeller then delivered two knee strikes to Baruth's left thigh. The knee strikes had no affect and Officer Voeller noted that it did not appear that Baruth felt any pain. Officer Voeller then warned Baruth that he would be tased if he did not stop fighting. Baruth ignored the warning and continued to fight. Officer Voeller removed the cartridge from his taser and applied a drive stun to the lower left portion of Baruth's back. Baruth arched his back as the taser was applied and was able to knock the taser out of Officer Voeller's hands and onto the floor. The taser application did not appear to have any affect on Baruth. Shortly after the taser was knocked to the floor officers were able to gain control of Baruth's arms and get him into handcuffs.

Baruth was transported to Holy Family Hospital for via AMR for his methampetamine use. He was later booked into jail.

I later downloaded Officer Voeller's taser.

The forced used by Officer Rosenthal and Officer Voeller was within Lexipol policy and procedure as well as the defensive tactics manual. Baruth had displayed assaultive behavior, had access to possible weapons, had possibly used methamphetamine, had possibly committed several violent felonies (including 2nd assault and unlawful imprisonment), had an outstanding felony warrant, and had expressed a desire to flee. The force that was used help to prevent any injuries to the officers involved, Baruth, and Gray.

On 030312 at 1716 hrs, Ofc. Voeller and I responded to 5313 N Regal #213 reference a report of a domestic violence. Enroute, the complainant, Spring Brenner, called police to report her friend, "Angie" later identified as Angela Gray, had texted her that her boyfriend was hitting her and would not let her leave. Both were possibly high. Radio confirmed a felony warrant on Cabbie Baruth, known to be Angie's boyfriend, before we arrived. He showed to have a history of violence and being associated with the Sureno's.

Upon arrival, we were let into the secured apartment building and walked to room 213. It was all quiet from the hallway. Ofc. Voeller knocked on the door and Angie answered after several knocks. Angie seemed scared and was speaking very fast. She opened the door to let us in and said her exboyfriend came over and stole her money to buy Meth. She said Cabbie was in the back room. He had hit her, forcefully gave her Meth, and was refusing to leave her apartment.

I followed Ofc. Voeller to the living room where I saw Cabbie pacing by the far window. He was very nervous, shaking, sweaty, and talking very fast. His hands were clenched and he shook his head saying he would not talk to us. He kept looking past us and it seemed he was getting ready to run. With a quick glance, I saw the room was cluttered with several metal objects, and possibly knives.

It was clear for everyone's safety we needed to take control of Cabbie right away in case he became violent towards us, and in order to continue our investigation. Ofc. Voeller stepped forward to take right arm control of Cabbie, as I attempted to take left arm control. I felt Cabbie pull away, and tighten his entire body. He tried pulling his arms inward. I felt us all fall forward, and as we did so. I applied a Carotid Neck restraint with my right arm to attempt to gain control of him.

We fell onto the couch. I was on my left side on top of my Taser, and Cabbie was on his left side next to me. His hands were underneath him and he was being non-compliant with commands to bring his hands out from under him. I kept the Carotid on but he did not lose consciousness. Cabbie kept saying how he could not breath, and that he would comply, but he refused to follow commands when I told him to get his arms out from under him. I changed the Carotid hold to my left arm in an attempt to gain better compliance from Cabbie, but he kept saying he could not breathe.

I kept the Carotid on Cabbie until handcuffs were on. I heard Ofc. Voeller tase Cabbie but it was ineffective. Cabbie said, "ok i'm done, I'm done" and brought both arms behind him to be handcuffed. He still continued to resist, but eventually, together, Ofc. Voeller and I were able to handcuff him. Once they were on, and he was standing up, I advised him he was under arrest and that he had the right to remain silent and to counsel.

Search incident to arrest, I found a small black container in his right front pants pocket. It contained a white crystal substance that field tested positive for Methamphetamine. Cabbie was brought down to Ofc. Geren's patrol car but was then transported to Holy Family ER via ambulance for ingestion of Meth.

I looked around the apartment then and saw there were several knives, screwdrivers, tweezers, and other dangerous objects on the couch we had just been lying on. On the counters, there were used needles, new needles, knives, a scale, and other paraphernalia.

I went to the bedroom where Ofc. Madsen was talking with Angie. Angie said she was high on Meth and showed us bruises on her legs and one on her arm. She said Cabbie had kicked her many times in the legs over the past few days.

Based on Angie's injuries, Angie's statement, and her and Cabbie's relationship status, I determined there was PC to charge Cabbie with City Assault/DV. Sgt. Braun was advised. See Ofc. Madsen's additional report. Cpl. Griffin photographed Cabbie's lower back area where he was Tased and Angie's bruises for evidence. I placed the Meth onto Property as Evidence.

I wrote a PC affidavit and Cabbie was booked for his felony warrant, City Assault/DV, and PCS Methamphetamine. PC exists for Obstructing.

On 03-03-13 at approximately 1646 hrs, Officer Rosenthal and I responded to 5313 N Regal # 213 in regards to a Domestic Violence call. The complainant, Spring Brenner, called in stating that her friend, Angela (Angie Gray) texted her five minutes ago stating that her boyfriend was hitting her and not letting her leave.

While enroute, Radio Dispatch advised that the male half, Cabbie E Baruth #4b had an outstanding Felony Warrant. This Warrant was confirmed through records. At this time, I pulled up a picture of Baruth from Mobile SPRS.

Officer Rosenthal and I went to apartment #213. I knocked on the door but no one answered. I knocked a second time and a female opened the door. I asked her if she was Angela to which she said she was. Gray looked and appeared scared, her eyes were wide open and she couldn't seem to sit still. Her speech was fast and coming out in quick words, not in smooth sentences. I told her we were here because a friend was worried about her. Gray said Baruth was here and he would not leave. She said Baruth had been hitting her and said he told her if she made him leave, he would kill her. Gray kept looking back into the apartment as we spoke.

I could see down the hall from the doorway I was standing in but I could not see the whole apartment. I asked Gray if Baruth was still here. Gray stepped around towards the apartment and said yes. I stepped in front of Gray as she came further into the apartment to ensure she would not come in between me and Baruth, putting her in any further danger.

As I came down hall, Baruth came out of the east side bedroom. Baruth looked right at me. I was 100% positive this was Baruth from the picture I had viewed before I arrived on scene. The tattoo on his neck was the same as the picture.

Baruth went straight to the far west wall. As he walked, he placed both hands into his pocket. He turned, took his hands out of his pocket and looked right at me telling me to get away from him. Baruth has a lighter in his hand and something else that I could not see because he balled up his fist. Baruth had his feet in a bladed stance like a fighting stance of a boxer. Baruth said he was having a cigarette and if I touched him he would jump out the window.

Baruth's speech was very fast and he appeared extremely agitated. His jaw was clenched

and he seemed to be tensing up his body. Baruth kept looking past me towards the couch and exit. I tried telling Baruth to calm down but he would not. I did not feel safe for Officer Rosenthal or I with the way Baruth was acting. There was a couch two feet away from where we were standing. Laying on this couch I could see several open bladed knives, screwdrivers and other tools and culinary that could be used as weapons. The kitchen counter had several open culinary knives and pocket knives lying on it. It was not a safe environment to have Baruth sit on the couch or even be wondering around the apartment with the weapons around.

I believed it would be in the best interest of everyone's safety if we handcuffed Baruth before furthering out investigation. I reached out to get a hold of Baruth and he immediately tried pulling back. I got ahold of his right arm and attempted to place it behind his back. Baruth lunged forward trying to get past me. I was still holding onto Baruth as we reached the front of the couch. I did not know at this time if Baruth was trying to access one of the weapons on the couch. To further gain control of Baruth, I tried taking him down to the ground with a foot sweep but he ended up face down on the couch. Baruth's body was lying on top of his left arm. His right arm was down to his right side. He was lying on or within reach of the knife and screw driver I had seen earlier.

Several commands were given to Baruth to relax and place his hands behind his back. Baruth showed an extreme amount of strength, keeping Officers from bringing his arms behind his back to handcuff him. I was able to bring his right arm and wrist area behind his back. Baruth kept trying to pull this arm away from me. He was bucking his body upward. He had his two feet on the floor and was pressing against the floor in an attempt to stand up. Before he was able to stand up. I delivered a knee strike to the side of his left leg. This brought Baruth back down on the couch. Baruth kept trying to roll his body around in an attempt to get away from police. I did not want to disengage at this time for fear that he would access a weapon off the couch.

Several times, Baruth stated he would bring his left arm behind his back as Officers instructed. Every time we let up a little to give him a chance to remove his arm, Baruth would fight harder to get his right arm out of my hold. He would not place his left hand behind his back. During the struggle, my radio microphone came off of the shoulder strap and was dangling between out bodies. I could not call for assistance at this time. Once Baruth was pinned down (still not handcuffed at this time) I was able to reach down with one hand and call for further Officers to assist. Baruth again said he was going to listen and bring his left arm back. Baruth started too and his right wrist was handcuffed. Before we could get his left wrist handcuffed, he violently started struggling again. I was unable to hold onto both left and right wrist. With one handcuff attached to his right wrist, it gave Baruth another weapon to use on Officers if he got his right hand free.

I had tried 2-3 knees to his left thigh to gain compliance but he did not seem to fee pain of any kind. I took my taser out and removed the cartridge. I warned Baruth that if he didn't stop fighting with Officers he would be tased. Baruth continued to fight and disregarded my warning. I applied a touch stun with my taser to the lower left section of his back near his side. As soon as I pressed the

trigger, Baruth arched up and pushed with his feet. His right arm started to come to his side. The taser went to the floor so I could use both hands to control Baruth. The taser application only lasted a couple of seconds and did not work in any way to control Baruth.

Gray was standing behind us, yelling at us to get Baruth. She alternated between sitting down in the kitchen to standing up. I told Gray to go downstairs and let Officers in the building (This was a secure facility) and she left the apartment.

After several more attempts to bring both his arms back, Baruth's left arm was placed behind his back and he was handcuffed. A short time later, Officers arrived. Baruth was searched incident to arrest and walked downstairs.

Medics responded to look at both Baruth and Gray. Both of them were transported to the hospital for treatment due to the drugs in their system and the way they were acting.

Sgt Braun responded to the location and was advised of the incident. Sgt Braun downloaded my taser at the station.

Officer Madsen spoke with Gray. It was determined PC exists to charge Baruth for City Assault DV against Gray. I was advised by Officer Rosenthal that was found on Baruth's person.

On 03/03/2013 at about 1727 hours Officer Madsen and I responded to the apartment complex at 5313 N. Regal #213 to assist other officers on a call. From the radio traffic of the officers it was apparent that they were struggling with someone.

Upon arrival I observed Officer Jones and Officer Voeller standing inside the apartment next to a suspect later identified to me as Cabby Baruth. He was already cuffed but was still highly agitated. Officer Rosenthal was standing to one side and there was a female seated on the adjacent room floor, crying.

Officer Voeller asked me to take Baruth out of the building and secure him in the back of a patrol vehicle. As Officer Jones and I began to escort him out of the apartment he began yelling for his shoes and tried to kick the front door shut. I changed my grip to a modified escort hold with my left hand on his left bicep and my right hand controlling his left wrist.

Baruth alternated trying to go limp and pushing back with his legs to avoid being escorted from the building. Officer Jones and I were able to escort him down the stairs and out the front door. We placed him next to the rear of my patrol vehicle and attempted to search him incident to arrest. He slammed his forehead against the trunk and Officer Jones restrained him to prevent him from further trying to injure himself.

We were able to seat him in the back of my car, at which time Cabby told me that he had eaten two grams of methamphetamine (raw, not in a container.) I requested medics respond and evaluate Cabby. Medics responded and advised he would need further evaluation at Holy Family Hospital. I rode with Cabby in the ambulance to the hospital. I stayed with him until he was cleared by medical staff. Officer Madsen and I transported Cabby to the Spokane County Jail and booked him on Officer Rosenthal's charges as well as an outstanding felony warrant.

I did not conduct any further investigation.

On 03/03/12 at about 1727 hrs., Officer Geren and I responded to N. 5313 Regal Apt # 213 to assist officers who were asking for additional officers. It appeared from the officer's radio traffic that they were out of breath and physical fighting with an individual.

City Radio advised units that officer had responded to the residence reference a domestic dispute between an Angela M. Gray and a Cabbie E. Baruth.

Baruth showed to have an outstanding confirmed felony warrant for his arrest.

Upon arrival, I entered the apartment and observed Officer Voeller, Officer Rosenthal and Officer Jones had detained a male who was later identified as Baruth. I observed there were items scratched around the living room as if there had been a struggle. Officers were out of breath and said they had to fight with Baruth to place him in custody.

Gray wasn't making any sense and I had a hard time understanding what had occurred because she had taken "a lot more Meth than she usually does". (Due to Gray's erratic behavior, medic's responded)

After Gray was told medics were enroute, she appeared to calm down a little. She told

Officer Rosenthal was advised of the above. It was determined there was probable cause to arrest Baruth for City Assault/DV along with other charges.

Gray was transported by AMR to Deaconess due to her drug usage
