Summary:

On 05-28-13 at approximately 0030 hours Ofc. D. Harvey conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle in the alley behind 406 E. Montgomery. He stopped the vehicle for speeding. The driver appeared to be traveling at about 40 to 45 M.P.H. in a 25 M.P.H. zone. It should be noted that Ofc. Harvey was driving a fully marked patrol car and wearing his patrol uniform.

Ofc. Harvey knew the area where the traffic stop took place is currently listed as a "Hot Spot" due to the high level of criminal activity in the area. This address in particular, 406 E. Montgomery, is a known problem / drug location and Ofc. Harvey was actively looking for the suspect in a shooting, Barry R. Bush, in and around this location. Bush was reported to be armed with a handgun, an additional report stated he threatened another person with a gun several days ago, and he was making claims to shoot it out with the police. It was also known to Ofc. Harvey that Bush has an outstanding domestic violence assault warrant for his arrest.

Ofc. Harvey immediately recognized the passenger that exited the vehicle he stopped as the suspect he was looking for, Barry Bush. Ofc. Harvey ordered Bush to stop, told him not to move, and informed him he was not free to go. Bush took off running to the west into a dark alley and ran behind an abandoned car. Ofc. Harvey told Bush he was under arrest and ordered him to lay down on the ground. Bush refused. Ofc. Harvey advised over the radio that he was in foot pursuit with Barry Bush.

Ofc. Reese responded to the scene. Ofc. Reese is also familiar with the listed location, the fact that Bush is a suspect in a recent shooting, reports that he was armed with a gun, and wanted for a domestic violence assault warrant.

Ofc. Harvey closed distance with Bush as Ofc. Reese arrived. Ofc. Harvey took Bush to the ground but was unable to get control of Bush's left arm / hand because Bush tensed up and pulled it underneath him towards his lower abdomen. Ofc. Reese gained control of Bush's right

arm but observed Bush's actions with his left hand. Ofc. Reese feared the suspect may be trying to access a weapon and used a closed fist technique to deliver two strikes to the suspects lower abdominal area in an attempt to momentarily disrupt the suspect's mental process in order to facilitate a control technique. The technique worked and Ofc. Harvey was able to gain control of the suspect's left arm / hand.

I spoke to Bush at the scene. Bush was yelling and tried to talk over the top of me when I first contacted him but he eventually calmed down. Although he calmed down, his whole body continued to twitch and move despite being in handcuffs. His speech was also rapid. Based on my training and experience Bush appeared to be under the influence of a controlled substance. (stimulant)

Bush admitted he was aware he missed a court date that would result in a warrant for his arrest. He stated he has been arrested on six prior occasions and has spent most of his adult life in prison. He initially attempted to claim he did no know it was illegal to run from the police. However, he changed his story and admitted he has been arrested for running from the police on two prior occasions. He confirmed he heard Ofc. Harvey identify himself as a police officer and order him to the ground. He claimed he did not think he had to go to the ground unless he was ordered to the ground by a Sargent. He stated, "That's the way it works in prison." He claimed he went down to his knees and was taken to the ground by an officer. He stated a second officer moved in and hit him in the right side of his lower abdomen. Bush said he was not injured during the incident and allowed me to lift his shirt so I could see his lower abdominal area.

Cpl. Hager photographed the lack of any visible injuries on Bush's body.

I attempted to gather more information from Bush but he suddenly blurted out, "I tripped and fell." I asked him to explain what he was talking about and he kept repeating the same statement over and over. Bush would not provide me with any further information. I ended my interview at this point.

Given the totality of the circumstances, the amount of force used by both officers was reasonable, appropriate, and within policy.

Reviewer comment:

The officers had prior knowledge that Bush had been armed, fired his gun last week and made statements about shooting it out with police. Bush was taken to the ground and the officers were able to get control of his right hand, but Bush was actively trying to move his left hand towards his waist area. The two closed fist strikes were reasonable to gain compliance of a possibly armed subject reaching to his waist - where weapons are most commonly carried.

The use of force was reasonable and within Departmental Policy.

Based on the fact that the suspect had a warrant for domestic violence, his history of violence and firearm possession along with his attempt to flee and struggle with police and failure to comply, Officer Reese's actions were within policy and appropriate in order to gain control of the suspect.

NARRATIVE

On 05-28-2013 at approximately 00:30 hours, I (Ofc. Harvey) was working routine patrol in the Logan district. I was driving a fully marked patrol vehicle and I was wearing the uniform of the day. This area was labeled as a "Hot Spot" due to the recent rise in crime.

While traveling W/B on Montgomery Ave near Dakota St, I noticed a dark colored sedan turn onto Montgomery Ave, just ahead of me. The sedan took a few turns before it quickly accelerated W/B on Ermina Ave. The vehicle appeared to be trying to run from me, and appeared to be exceeding the speed limit. I estimated the vehicle's speed at approximately 40-45 mph. The vehicle turned into the South parking lot of 406 E. Montgomery, which is a well known problem/drug house.

Once the vehicle stopped I pulled directly behind it and activated my emergency lights. I noticed the passenger exiting the vehicle quickly. I immediately recognized the passenger as Barry R. Bush #4b

Barry was a suspect in a shooting from within the last week. Yesterday, other officers and I were trying to track down Barry, who also had a DV-Assault 4th warrant. I was advised that everyone that has had recent contact with Barry is afraid of him. One person claimed two days ago Barry threatened him with a gun. They also stated that Barry was making claims that he would shoot it out with police.

After recognizing Barry I yelled to him, "Stop, don't move." Barry had a handful of items and appeared to be in a hurry to walk away. I yield at him again, "Stop, your not free to go." I started to walk up to Barry, who then backed away from me. Barry started walking around the vehicle. I yelled at Barry again to stop.

Barry started running from me, W/B across Astor St and I gave chase to him. While chasing him I yelled, "Stop, your under arrest!" Barry continued to run, and went into the back yard of 2127 N. Astor St.

There was a vehicle parked in the back yard. Barry ran behind the vehicle and faced me. Barry had a jacket in his hand, and I could not see if he had a weapon on him. I drew my gun and I yelled at him, "Get on the ground, your under arrest!" As I tried to round the car towards Barry, he would walk the opposit direction around the car. We started to walk circles around the car. The entire time I continued to give him commands to get on the ground and to show his hands. Barry put his jacket on the back of the vehicle and put his hands up. Barry started to yell at me, "Are you a cop, whats your name?" I yelled back, "Yes, I'm Ofc. Harvey, get on the ground, your under arrest." We continued to make circles around the vehicle and he was not complying with my commands.

Ofc. Reese arrived on scene and pulled up behind Barry. Barry stopped for a second, which gave me time to approach him. I grabbed onto Barry and did a rear take down. Barry was then lying face down. Ofc. Reese and I gave him commands to put his hands behind his back. Barry's left hand

I searched Barry incident to arrest. I did not find any weapons or anything of evidentiary value.

I transported Barry to the Spokane County Jail where he was booked on his warrant and for charges of Resisting Arrest (10.07.034), citation #3Z0496292. Barry also became uncooperative with the jail staff.

I assisted Officer Harvey who was in foot pursuit of Barry Bush on May 28, 2013 at 0030 hours. I knew that Barry was allegedly involved in a shooting incident around 1600 E Pacific. Barry was supposed to be armed with two hand guns and he also had an outstanding DV assault warrant. There was no probable cause for Barry regarding the shooting at this time. I heard Officer Harvey come on the air and say that he was in foot pursuit of Barry Bush.

I arrived on scene and saw Officer Harvey in the alley to the southwest of Montgomery and Astor. There was a broken down car near the alley. Officer Harvey was standing on the west side of the car facing east. He had Barry at gun point and was yelling at him to get on the ground. Barry was on the east side of the vehicle facing Officer Harvey. I pulled into the alley and got out of my patrol car as Officer Harvey approached Barry. I saw Officer Harvey grab Barry and then he did a take down. I was getting out of my patrol car so I did not see exactly how Officer Harvey grabbed Barry. I also did not see what Barry was doing as Officer Harvey approached him.

Barry landed on the ground face down with Officer Harvey on top of him. I ran up and grabbed Barry's right arm and pulled it out to his side. I heard Officer Harvey yelling at Barry to get his hand out from underneath him. I saw Officer Harvey trying to pull Barry's left arm out from underneath his body. I started telling Barry to put his hands behind his back. Barry was allegedly armed with two hand guns and had already shot at someone. His left hand started out at about his nipples and moved down to his belly button. I did not want Barry reaching for a weapon so I continued to yell for him to get his hands out to his side. Officer Harvey was still trying to pull Barry's left arm out and gain control of him.

Barry was still not complying and I was concerned that he was trying to access a weapon. I delivered two closed fist strikes to Barry's lower abdomen. He immediately pulled his left arm out to his side and was placed in handcuffs. Barry was not injured from the closed fist strikes and did not complain of injury. Sgt Keller was on scene and I advised him of the incident. Barry requested a supervisor and Sgt Keller contacted him. Barry was arrested on his outstanding DV assault warrant and transported to jail by Officer Harvey. See his report for further.
